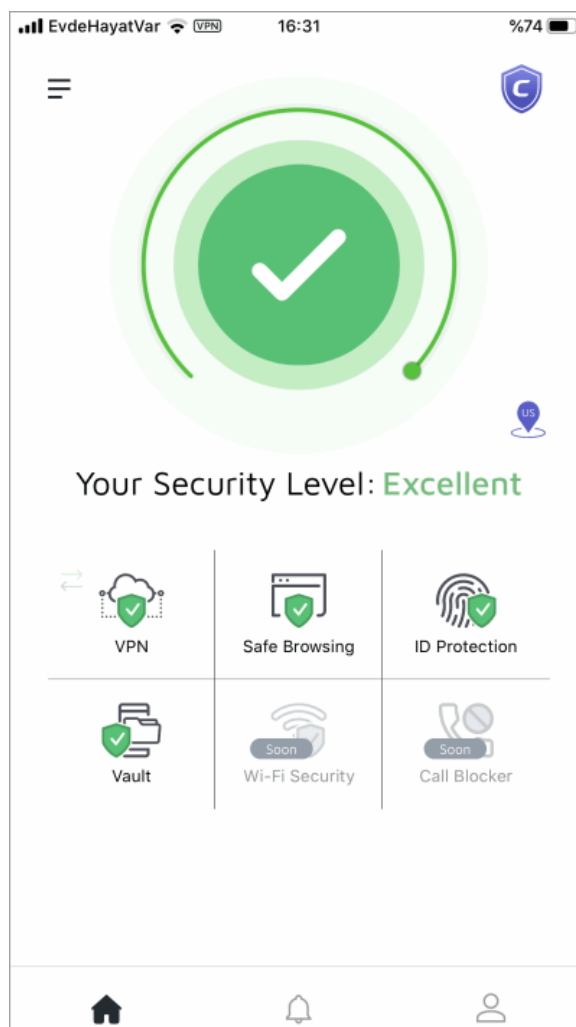

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1. Introduction

Comodo Mobile Security (CMS) protects iOS devices against harmful websites, eavesdropping, identity theft and more.



Features

- **Safe Browsing** - Advanced web filter protects you online by instantly blocking harmful websites
- **ID Protection** - Receive alerts if your personal data is found on the dark or deep web
- **VPN** - Private, secure and anonymous internet access. Unlimited traffic for premium users
- **Vault** - Highly secure storage for important items. Access to this area is protected by face recognition, fingerprint or pattern.

CMS is available as free and paid versions:

- **Free**
 - Safe Browsing
 - ID Protection - Protection for one email address (your sign-up address)
- **Paid** - Available in monthly and yearly subscription models
 - Safe Browsing
 - ID Protection - Protect up to 20 email addresses and 20 credit cards
 - VPN - Unlimited traffic

- Vault - Keep your important items in a protected environment.

All other features are the same for both versions.

2. Download and Install Comodo Mobile Security

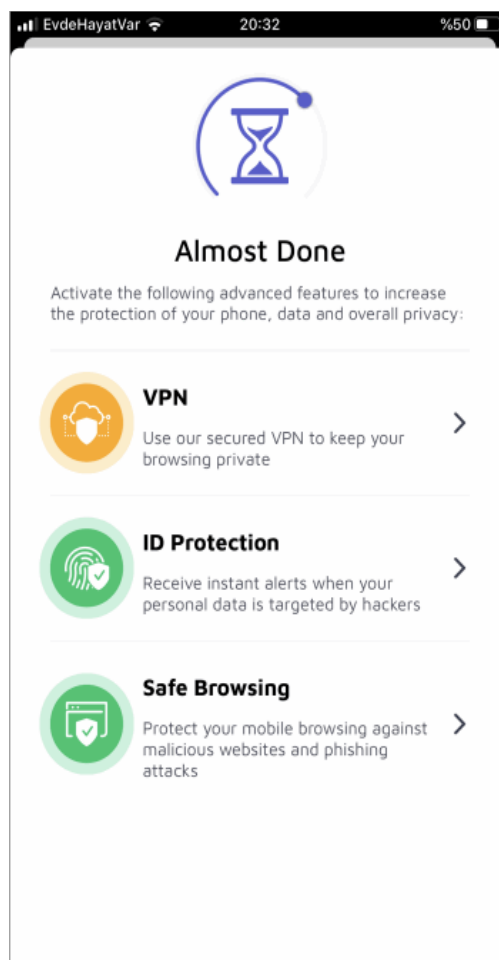
You can download Comodo Mobile Security (CMS) from the Apple App Store at <https://itunes.apple.com/cy/app/comodo-mobile-security/id1448853386>

Note: You need an Apple account to download CMS from the App Store.

Once the CMS for iOS is installed, the main interface will open:



- Click the yellow circle to start the activation to enhance your device protection:



3. Create a CMS Account

You need to create a Comodo Mobile Security (CMS) account to enable the following services:

- Safe Browsing
- ID Protection

Safe browsing does not require a CMS account.

Sign-up is quick and easy:

- Open Comodo Mobile Security on your mobile device
- Touch the user icon at the bottom-right of the home screen
- Open the 'Sign up' tab at top-right

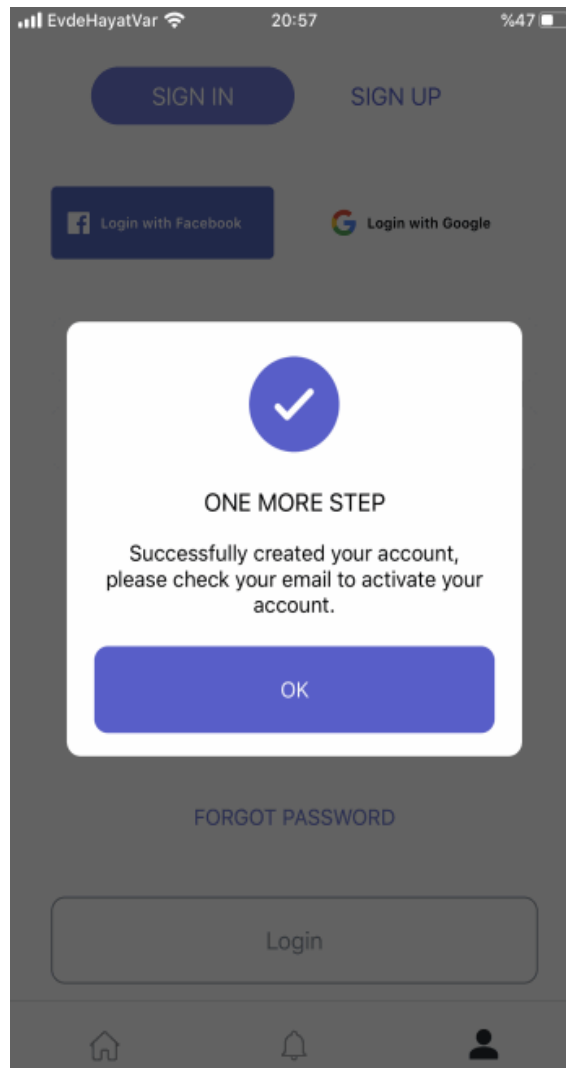

- Email - Enter your contact mail address. This will double up as your account login name.
- Password - Create an account password and confirm it.
- Note - You can also signup to CMS using your Facebook or Google account.
- Touch 'Register' to submit your request
- Tap 'Next' after reading 'Terms of Use' and 'Privacy Policy'

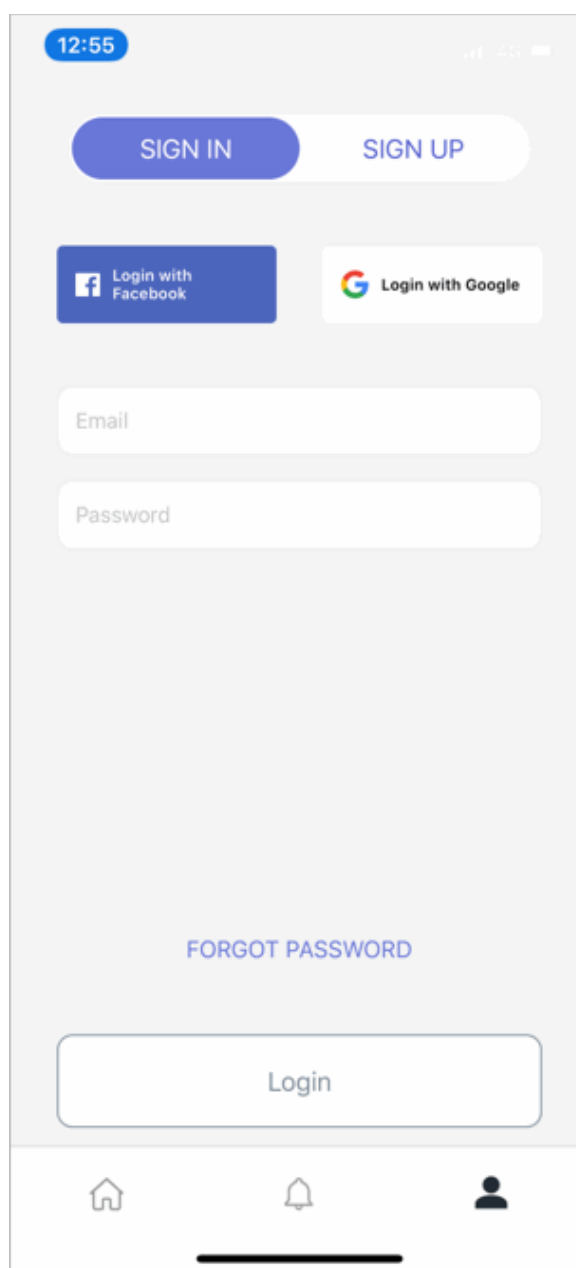
We will send an account activation mail to your contact email address:



- Simply touch the activation link in the mail to activate your account.
- As a thank-you for using CMS, we also add your contact email address to our 'ID Protection' service, free of charge. Our 24/7 monitoring service will alert you if your address is found on the dark or deep web.
- You can protect multiple email addresses by **upgrade to a CMS Premium account**.

4. Sign-in to your CMS Account

- Open Comodo Mobile Security on your mobile device
- Touch the user icon at the bottom-right of the home screen
- Make sure the screen is open at the 'Sign In' tab:

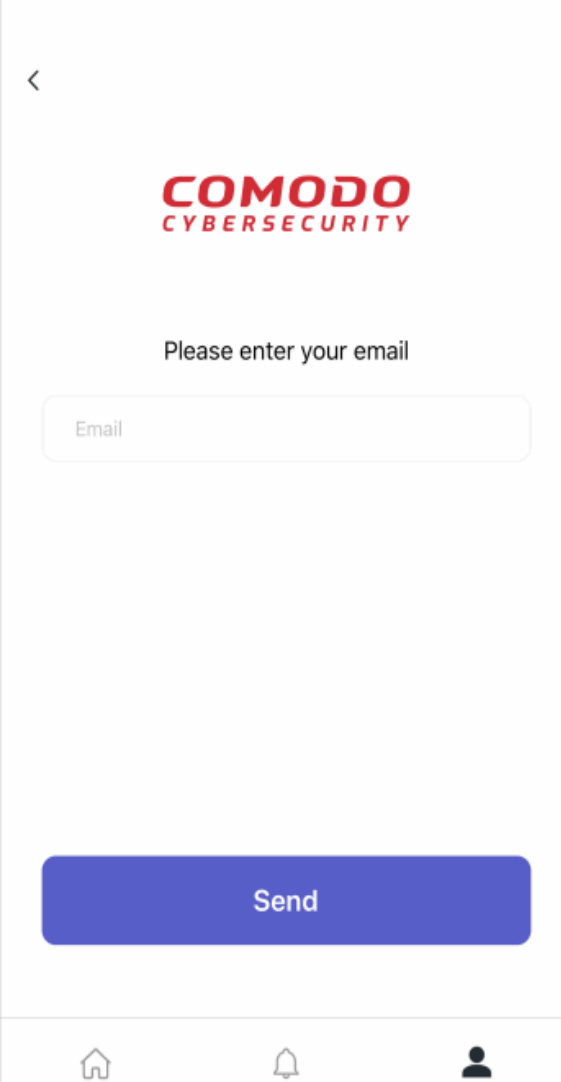


- Enter your username (email address) and password. Tap 'Login'
 - Note - You can also login to CMS using your Facebook or Google account.

Forgotten Password

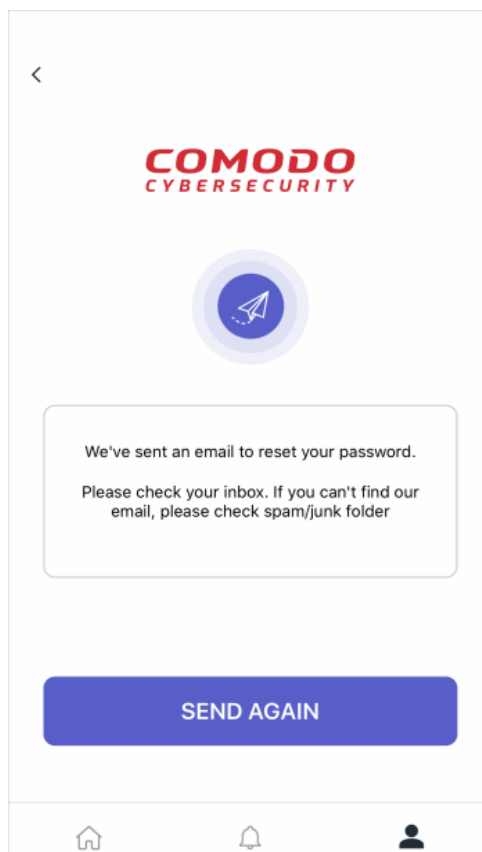
You can reset your password if you cannot remember it.

- Tap the 'Forgot Password?' link on the login screen

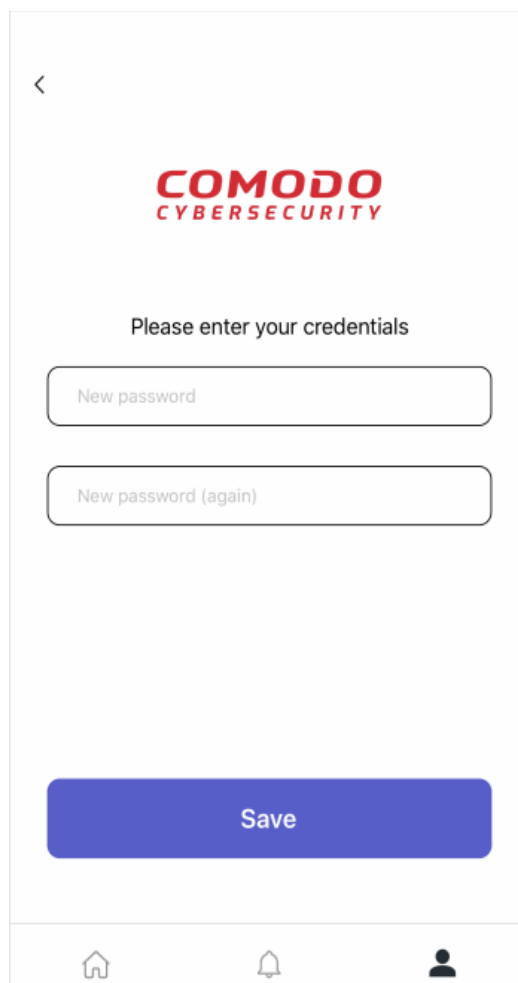


- Enter your login email address and hit 'Send'

- Open the mail on your phone and touch the activation link. Check your spam / junk folder if you can't see it in your inbox. Note - the password reset link is not supported in desktop browsers.

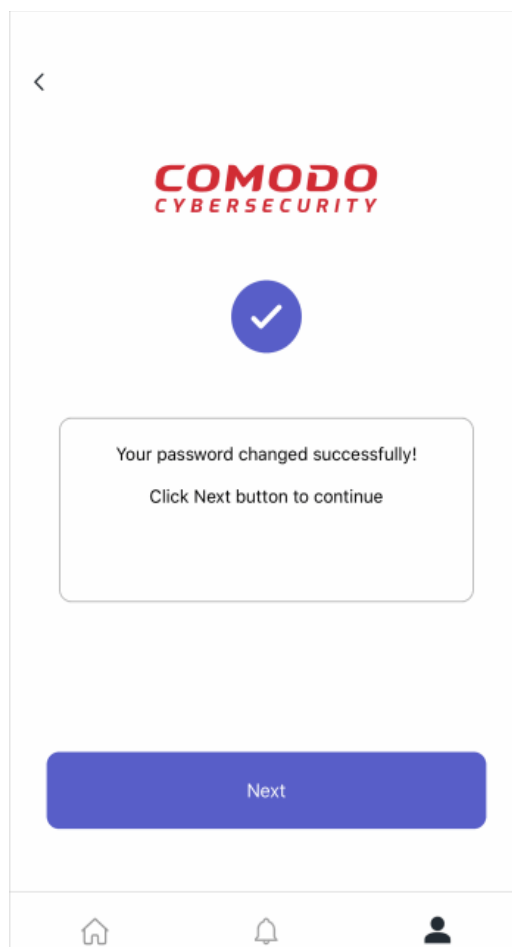

- Hit 'Save'

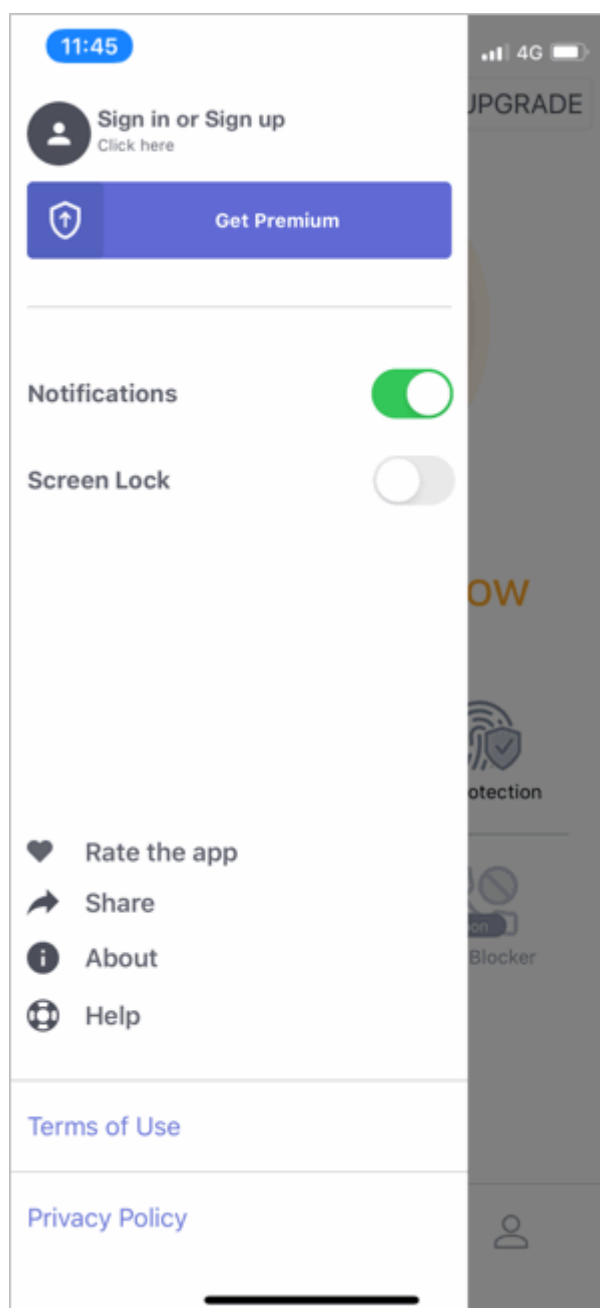


- Your new password is activated. Tap 'Next' to open CMS login screen.

5. Configure Screen Locker

With screen lock enabled, you need to provide fingerprint or face authentication to open CMS. The options on the left let you configure the behavior of the screen locker.

- Open Comodo Mobile Security
- Login to your account (optional)
- Touch the hamburger icon at top-left, or swipe the screen to the right:



- Enable or disable screen lock as required.

6. Upgrade your Account

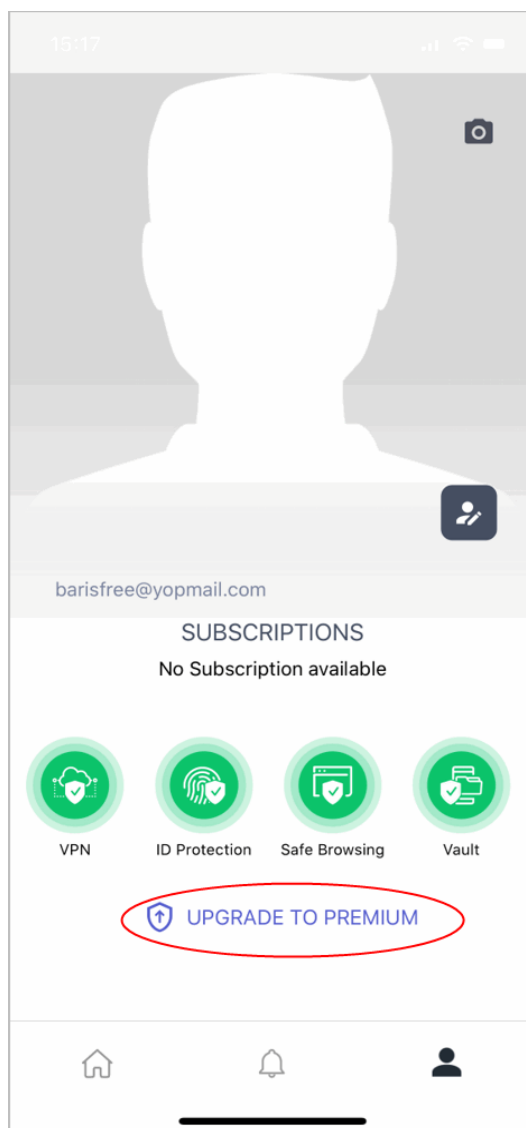
A premium account lets you enjoy unlimited VPN traffic and offers protection for up to ten email accounts.

- Open Comodo Mobile Security and sign in to your account
- Select 'Upgrade to Premium' or 'Upgrade' on the home screen:

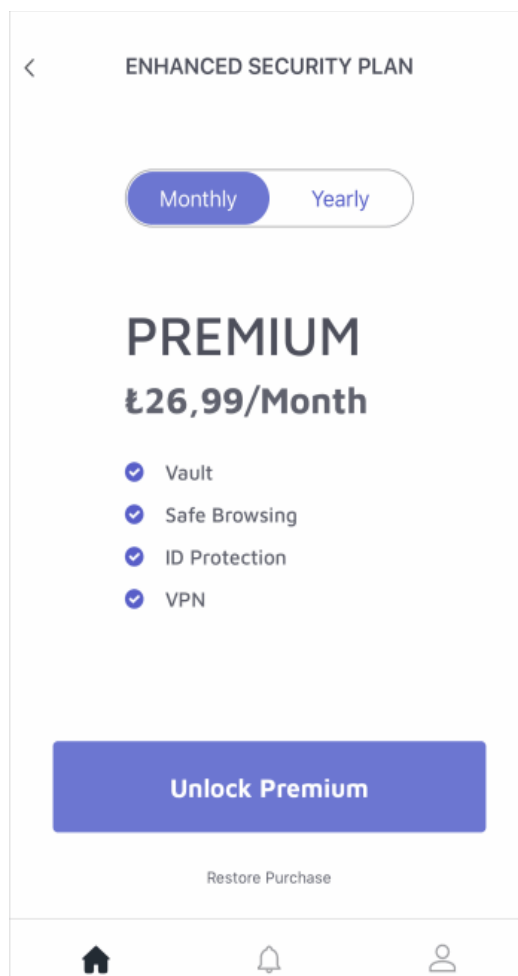


OR

- Tap the user icon on the home screen then select 'Upgrade to Premium' on the profile screen:



- You will be taken to the license selection page:



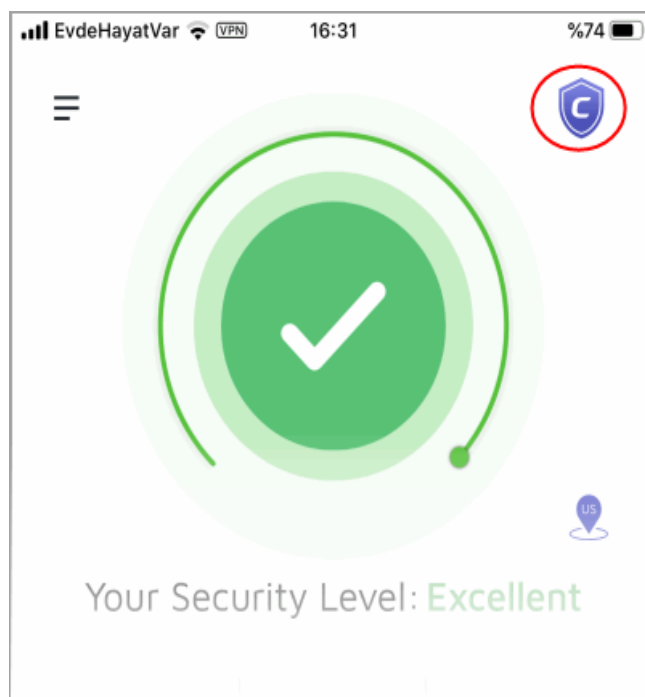
- Select your preferred plan then tap 'Unlock Premium'
- Complete the purchase by entering your payment details
- Click 'Subscribe' and complete the payment process.
- Enter your password then tap the 'Verify' button.
- Your license is automatically activated once your payment has been processed.

Note 1 - You can obtain a license without creating an account, but the features are restricted as follows:

- No ID protection
- No Vault
- You can only use CMS on the device on which you purchased the license.

Note 2 - Premium users can use CMS on any device, but only on one device at a time.

- Your subscription is activated on your device and the purple shield appears at top-right of the screen:



7. Safe Browsing

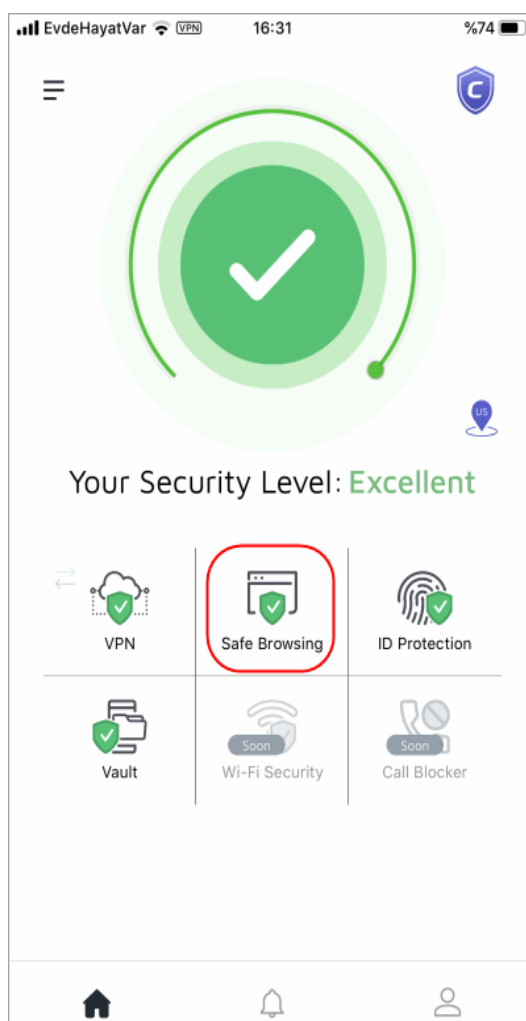
Tap the 'Safe Browsing' button on the home screen

Safe browsing is a website filter which protects you online by blocking malicious, misleading and fraudulent websites.

- Note - Make sure you are enable permissions for CMS on your device (iOS 'Settings' > 'Safari' > 'Content Blocker')
- Supported browsers - iOS browser (Safari)

Enable secure browsing

- Open Comodo Mobile Security
- Login to your account (optional)
- Tap 'Safe Browsing' on the home screen



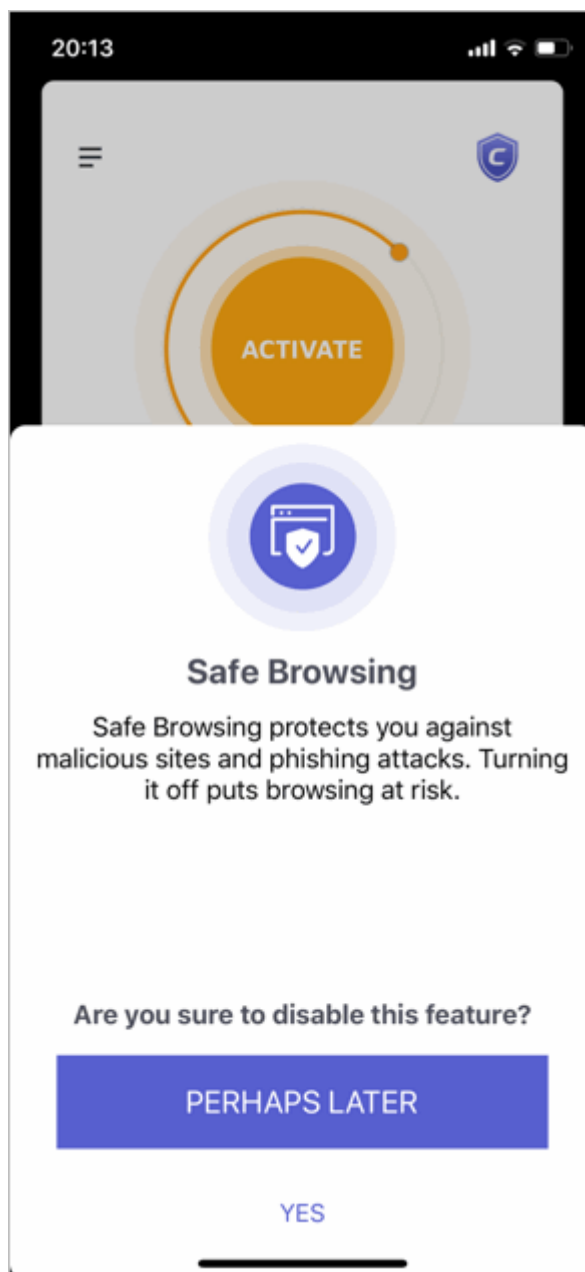
- Next, enable the CMS safe browsing feature
- Tap 'OK' to be taken to 'Settings' > 'Safari' > 'Content Blocker'
- Toggle the slider to 'On'
- CMS status will change accordingly

Note: If it is already enabled, disable and re-enable the toggle

- If you have not allowed the accessibility permission, CMS downloads the database of harmful websites. This constantly updated database protects you online against suspicious and phishing websites.

Disable Safe Browsing

- Touch the 'Safe Browsing' tile to access feature settings:



- Hit 'Yes' to disconnect.

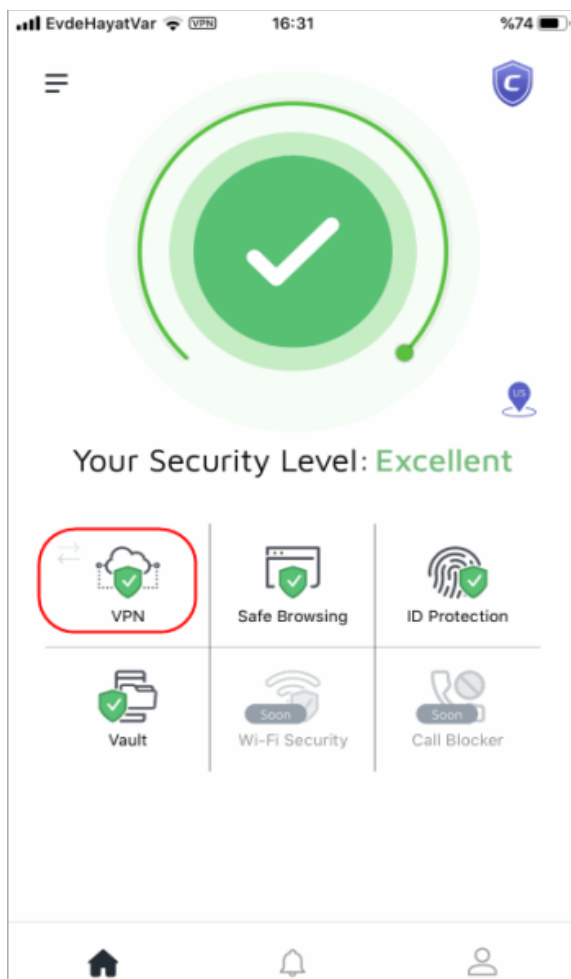
8. Virtual Private Network (VPN)

Tap the 'VPN' button on the home screen

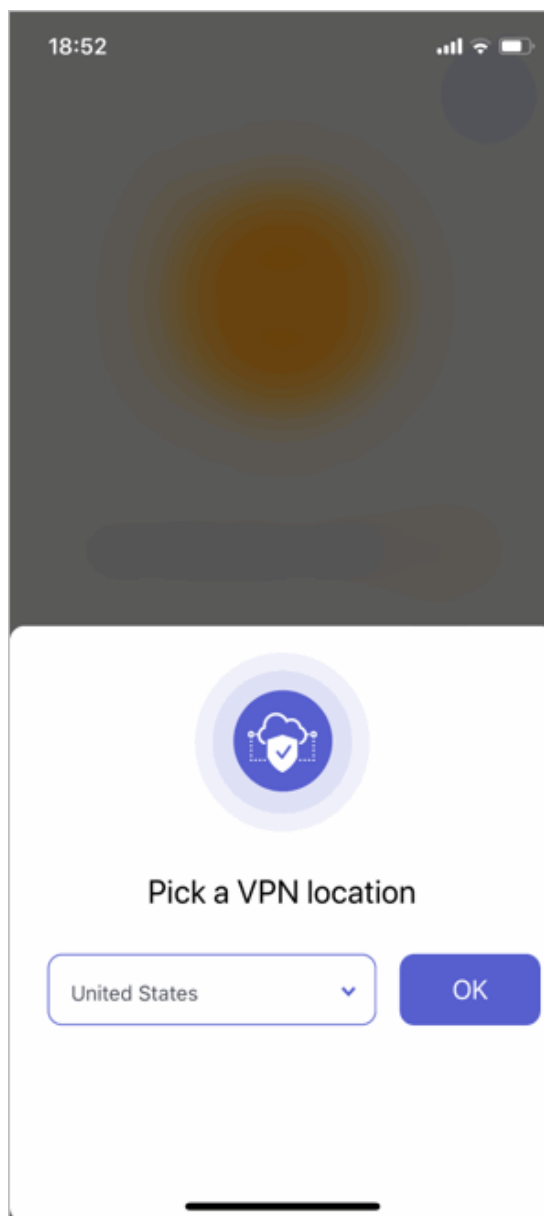
- A VPN allows you to securely and anonymously connect to the internet from any location
- This is especially useful to protect your communications when using public WiFi (cafes, airports, parks etc)
- Because all your traffic is encrypted, a VPN is a must when sending or receiving sensitive information
- The VPN service is available only on premium accounts. Traffic is unlimited. See '[Upgrade your CMS Account](#)' if you need help to get Premium.

Configure the VPN

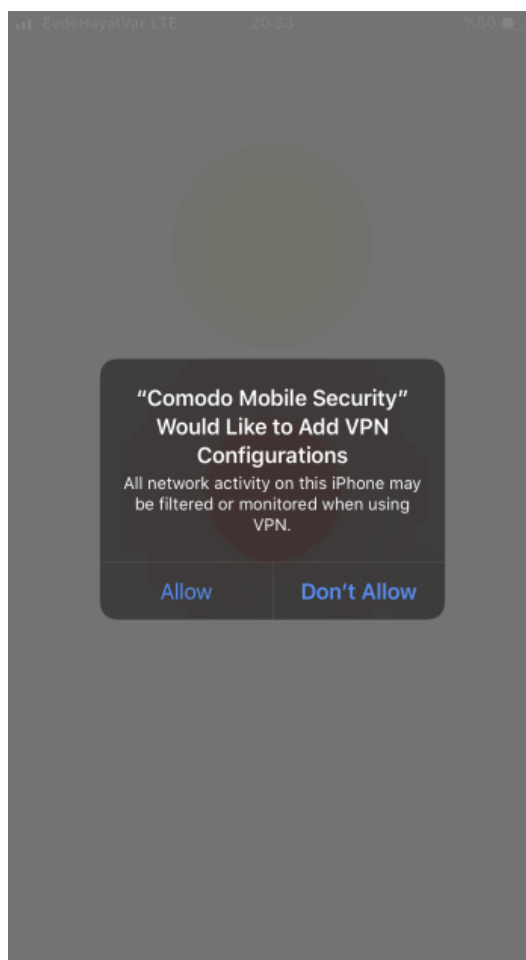
- Open Comodo Mobile Security
- Login to your account
- Tap 'VPN' on the home screen



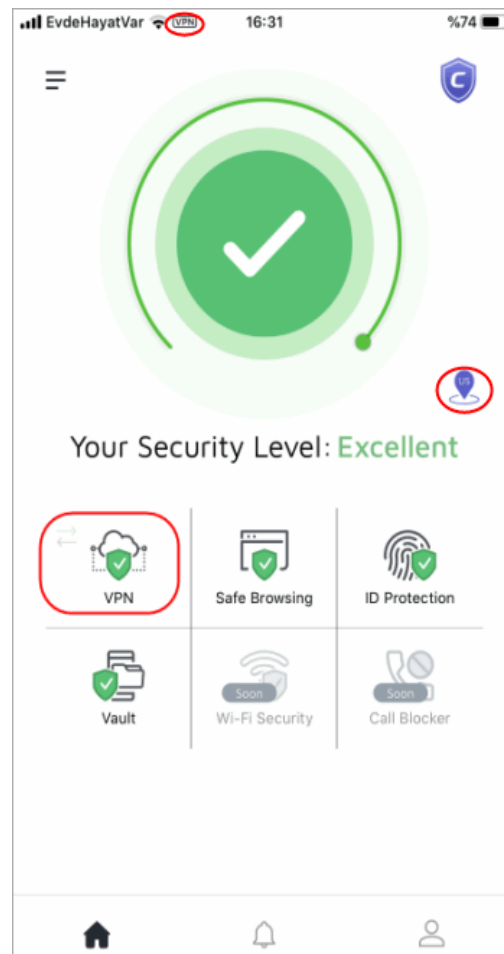
- Hit the arrow
- Select the VPN server through which you want to connect to the internet:



- Our VPN servers are strategically placed at different geo-locations to serve customers around the globe
- Select the server location from the drop-down and tap 'OK'
- Tap 'Allow' to let CMS setup your VPN connection:



- Note - the screen above only appears on the first connection
- The 'VPN' icon appears on the info bar at top-left when the service is active:

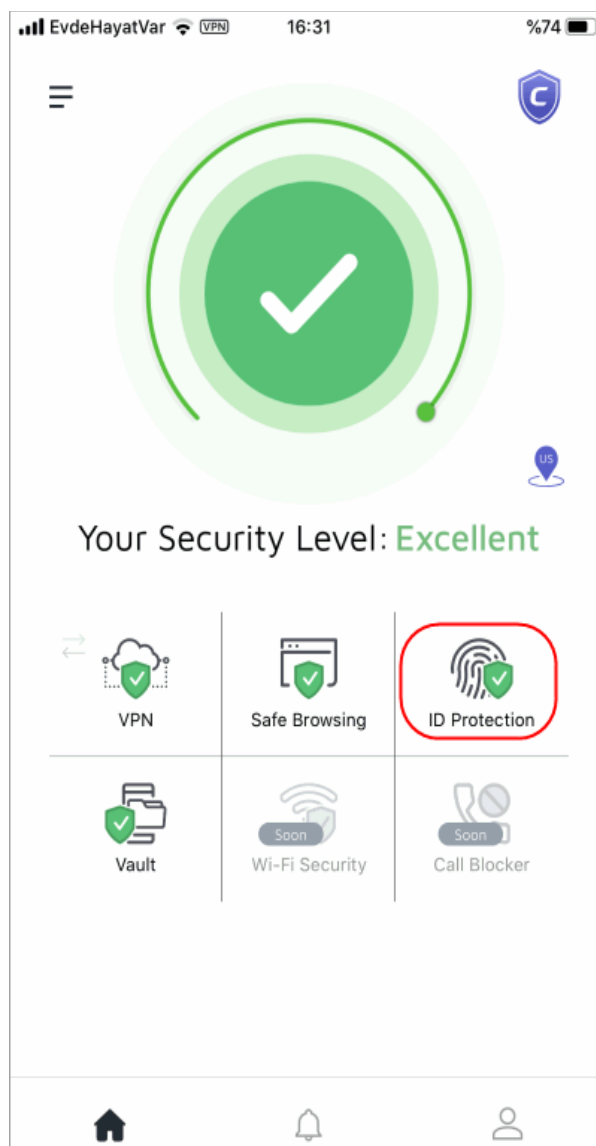


- Tap the VPN tile to disconnect.

9. ID Protection

Tap the 'ID Protection' button on the home screen

- The dark web is where cyber-criminals exchange stolen data and personal information. A significant chunk of this data is compromised email accounts and credit card numbers.
- Email addresses are of great value to hackers because many online portals also use them as your login name. If your email is found on the dark web, there's a chance that they also have the corresponding password.
- Your email address might be only part of a larger trove of your personal information. For example, the hackers may also have your social security number, home address or more.
- CMS continually monitors the dark/deep web and will alert you if it finds your email ID.
- We automatically add your sign-up email to the protection program, free of charge. You can protect more email IDs by upgrading to CMS premium. See '[Upgrade your CMS Account](#)' for help to do this.

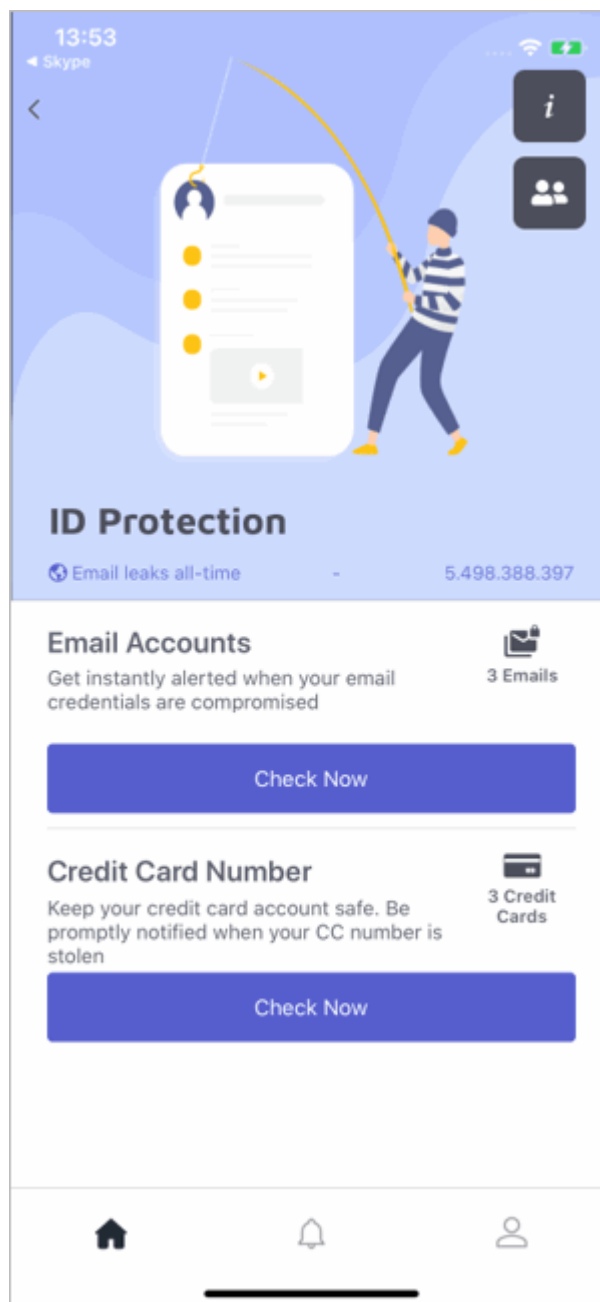


- **Email accounts** - The number below the mail icon shows how many email addresses are protected. Touch anywhere on the row to check for breaches. CMS will search immediately and show the result. [Click here](#) to view the result.
- **Credit Card Number** - The number below the card icon shows how many credit cards are protected. Tap to search the dark web for the credit card numbers you have added to CMS. [Click here](#) for help to setup credit card protection.

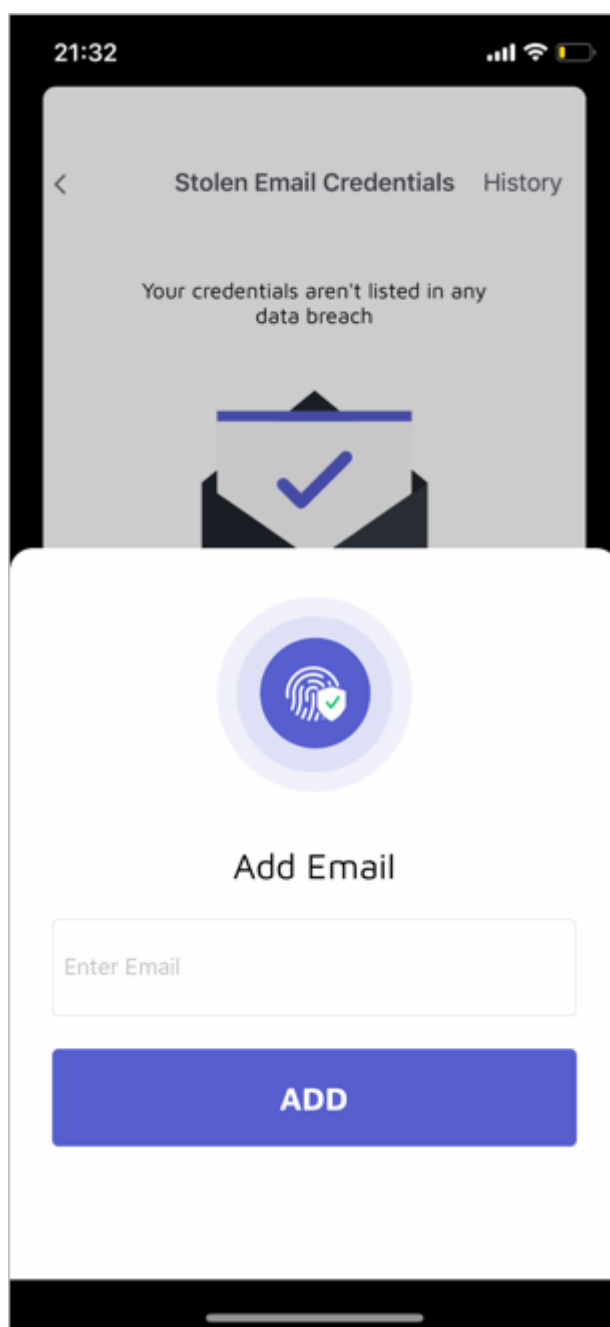

Email protection



Add addresses for protection

- Open Comodo Mobile Security
- Login to your account
- Open 'ID Protection' on the home screen
- Touch the  in the email accounts row
- Tap the '+' button on the bottom-right
- Enter the email address that you want to protect:

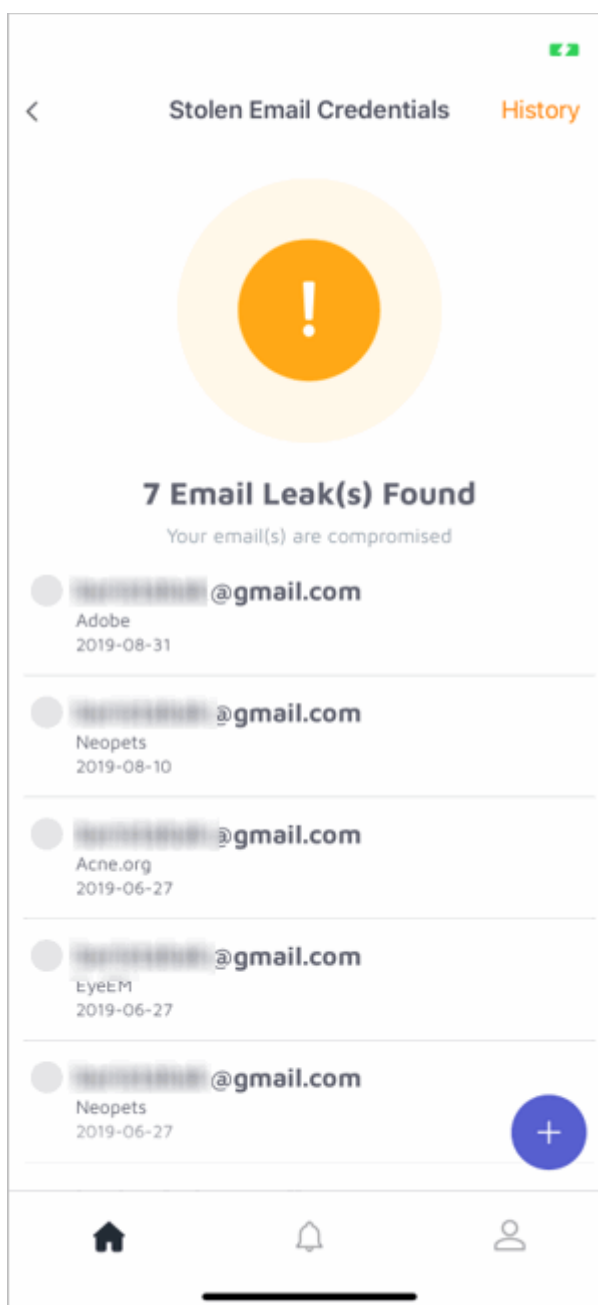


- Tap 'Add'
- Repeat the process to add more addresses
- We will send validation emails to all addresses that you enter
- Click the 'Validate' button in the email to confirm your control of the address
- The email address is added to the protected list after validation

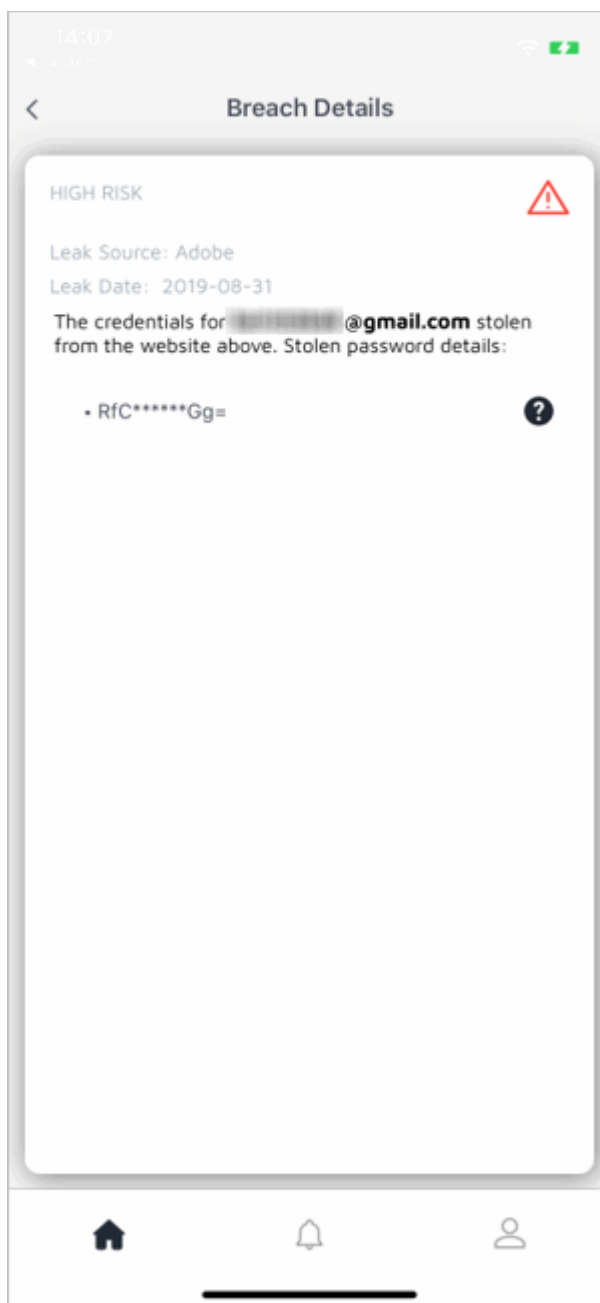
View status and manage protected addresses

- Open Comodo Mobile Security
- Login to your account
- Open 'ID Protection' on the home screen
- Tap 'Check Now' button on the email accounts row

- CMS will check and alert you if your address is found on the dark web
- You can add more email IDs from this screen by tapping the '+' button as explained above
- Tap the 'History' link at top-right to view the list of stolen email addresses:

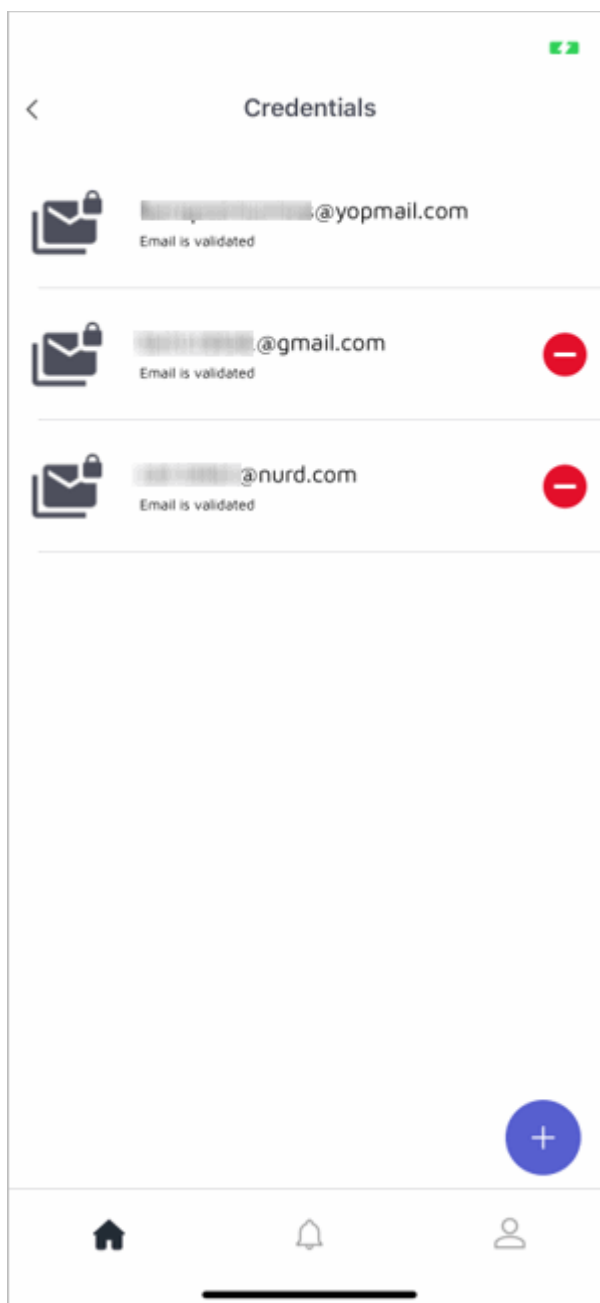


- Select the email credentials for which you want to see more details:



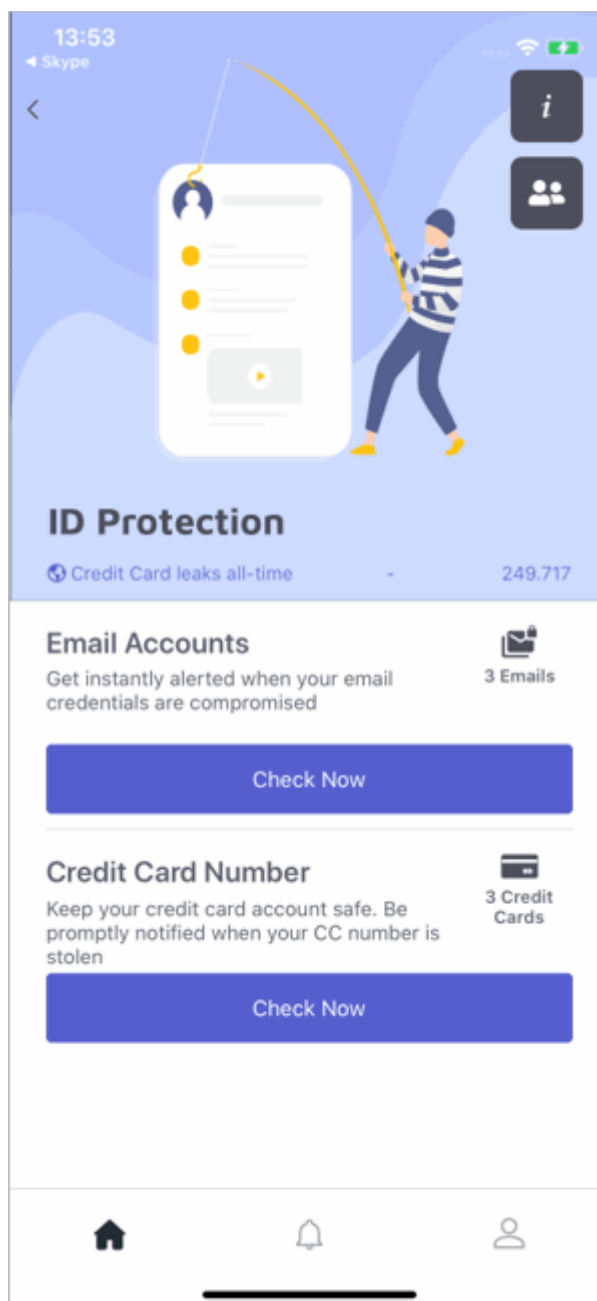
View email addresses

- Press the  icon to view all addresses you have added for protection:




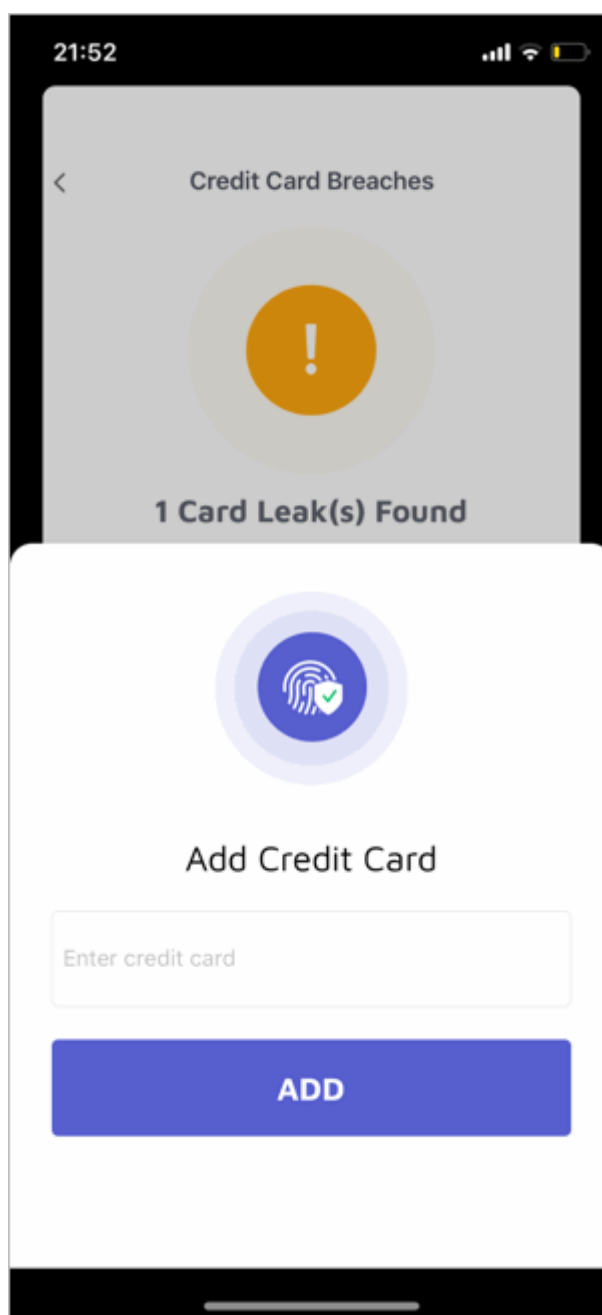
- Tap the '-' button to remove an address from the list then touch 'Yes' in the confirmation dialog

Credit card protection



Add credit cards for protection

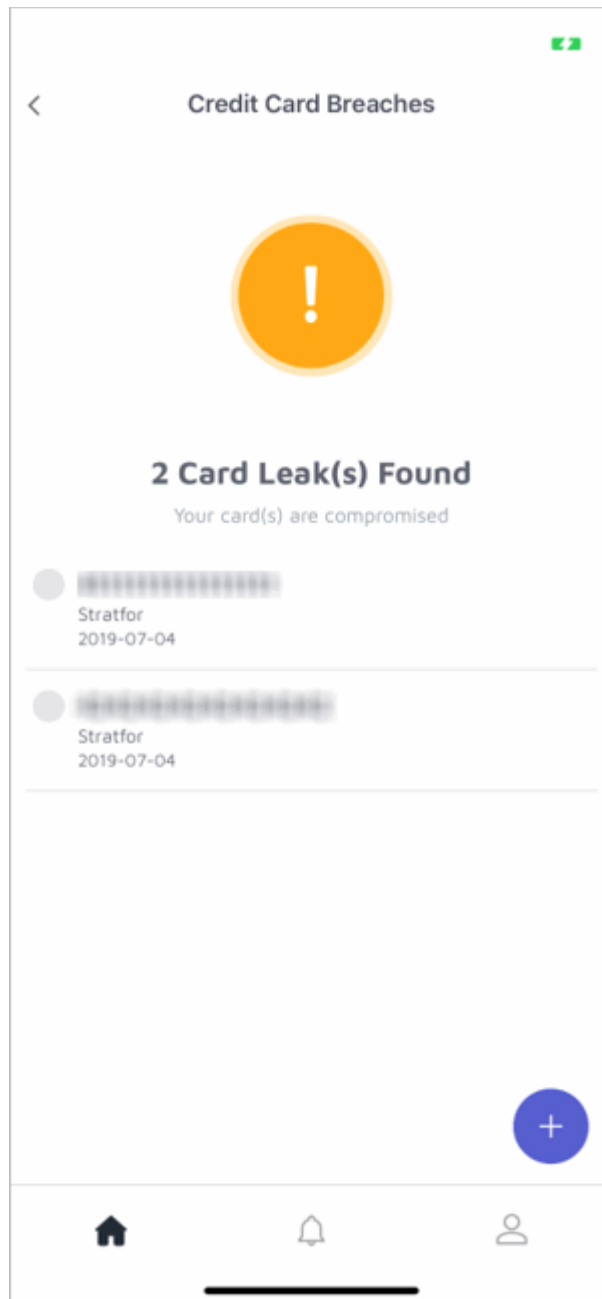
- Open Comodo Mobile Security
- Login to your account
- Open 'ID Protection' on the home screen
- Tap 'Activate' to add a credit card number if you have not yet added it
- Otherwise, tap the  icon
- Touch the '+' button



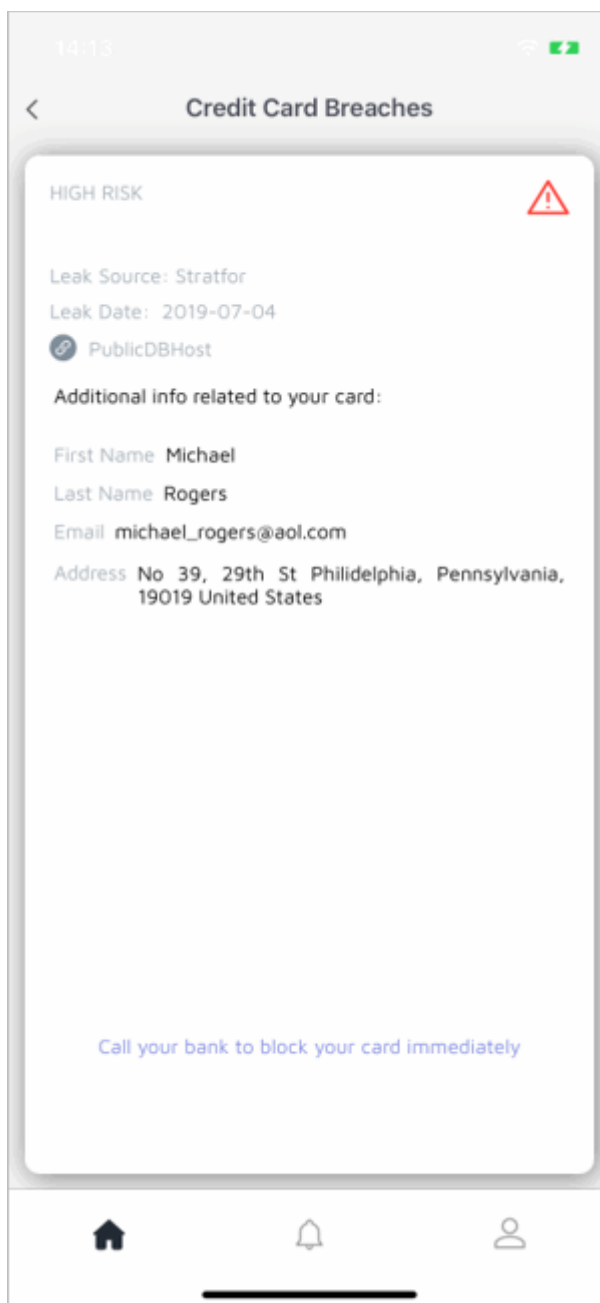
- Enter the credit card number then click 'Add'
- Repeat the process to add more card numbers

View security status


- Open Comodo Mobile Security
- Login to your account
- Open 'ID Protection' on the home screen
- Click the 'Check Now' button on the credit card row
- CMS will check the dark web and alert you if any of your cards are found:

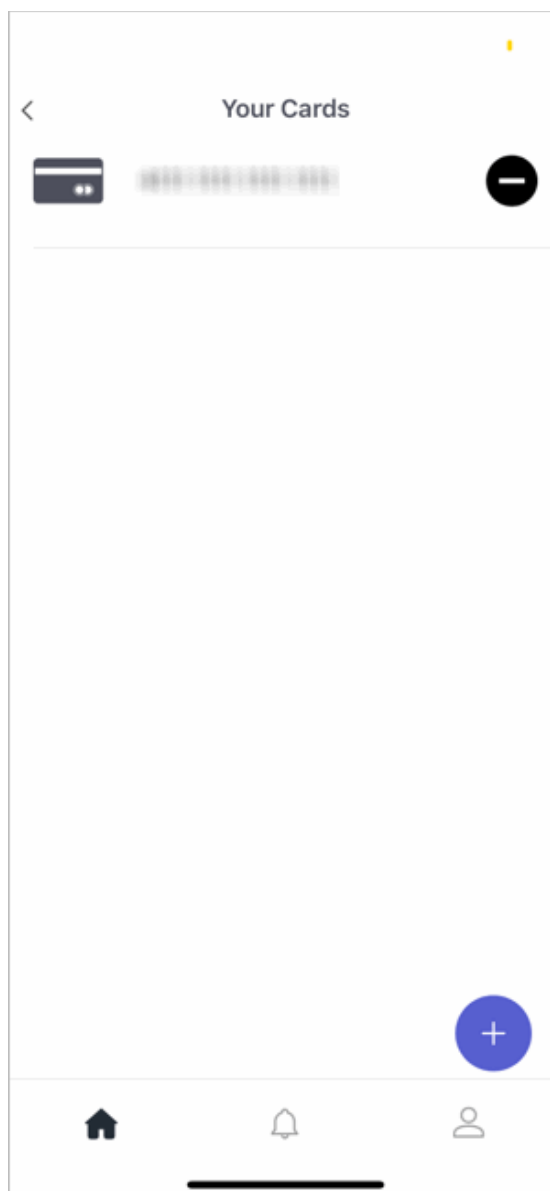


- Select the credentials for which you want to see more details:



Manage card numbers

- Press the  icon to view all cards you have added for protection:



- Tap the '-' button to remove a card from the list.

10. Vault

Tap the 'Vault' button on the home screen.

The vault is a secure area on your phone to store your private and confidential data.

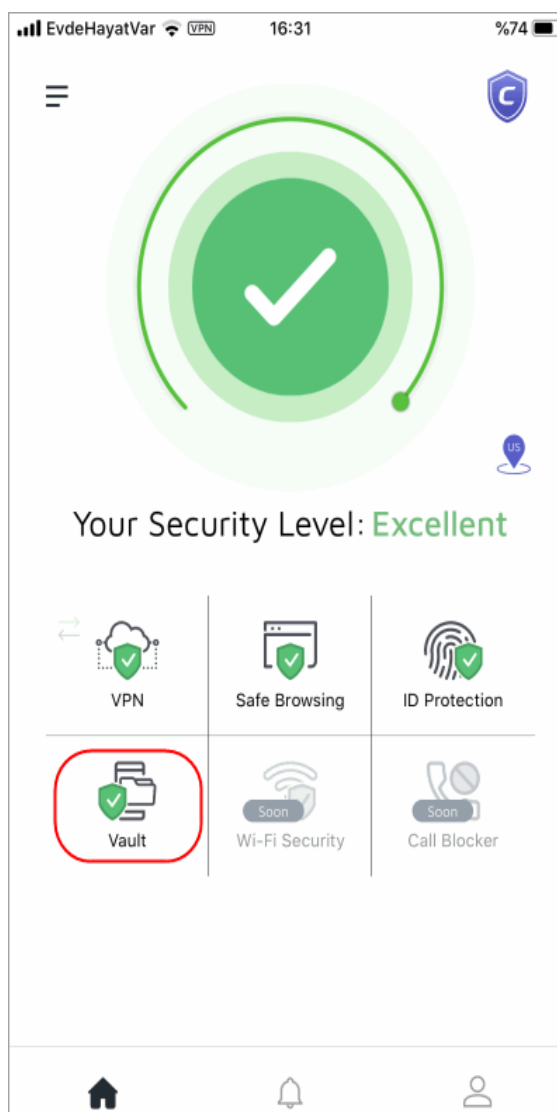
- Highly secure storage for videos, images and files that you want to keep private. Photos and videos in the vault do not even appear in the Android gallery.
- Items in the vault are locked behind an additional layer of face id, passcode or fingerprint authentication.
- No other apps on your device can read or access items in the vault. This includes 3rd party apps, websites you visit, and even Android services.
- Items in the vault are never uploaded to any cloud-backup service. They remain on your personal device

and can only be accessed by you.

The vault is available for Premium license holders. See '[Upgrade your CMS Account](#)' to see the full list of features you get with each license type.

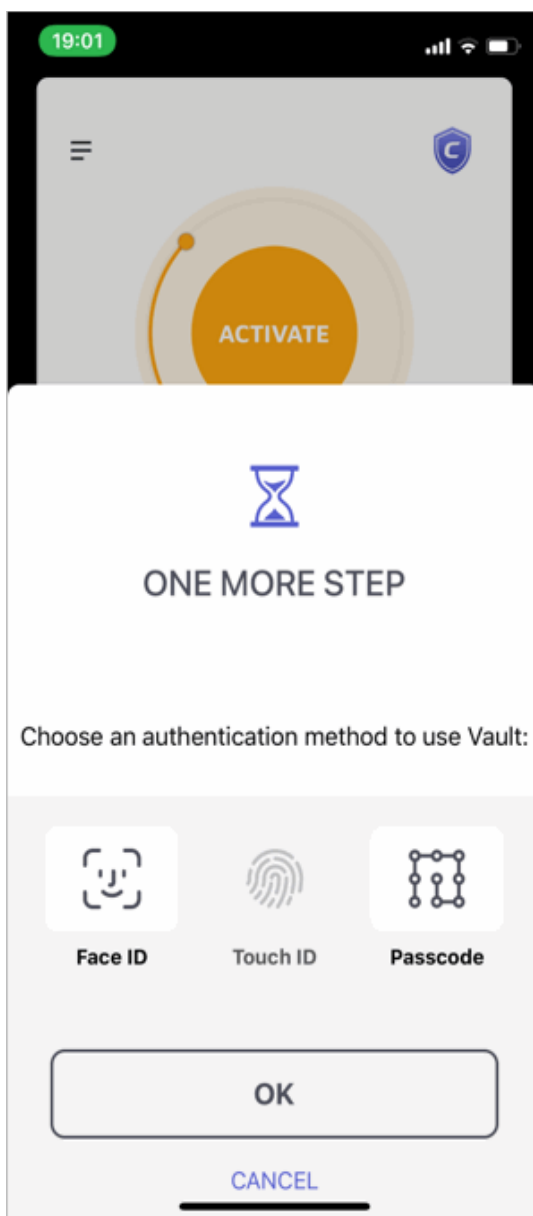
Configure the Vault

- Open Comodo Mobile Security app
- Login to your account
- Tap 'Vault' on CMS home screen

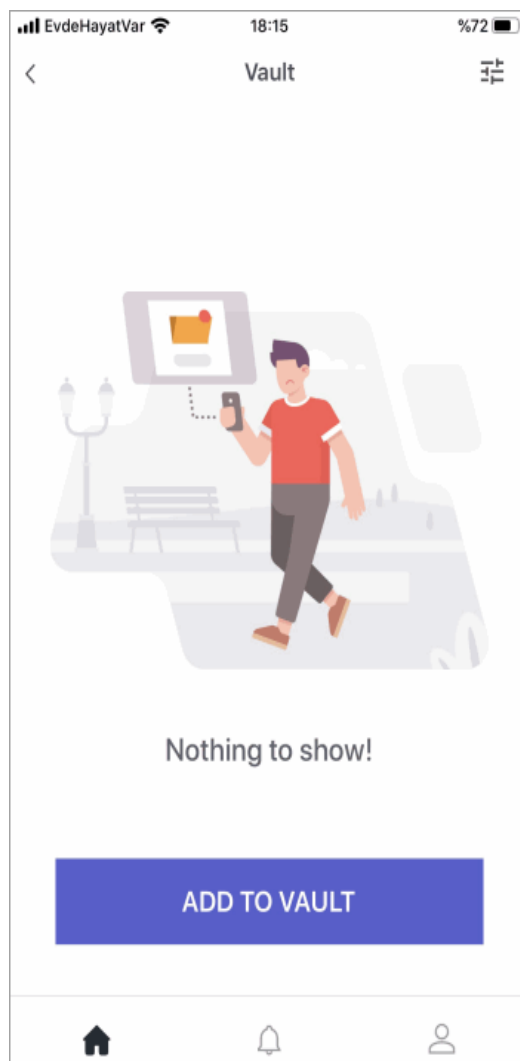


There are three authentication methods available:

- Face ID
- Touch ID
- Passcode

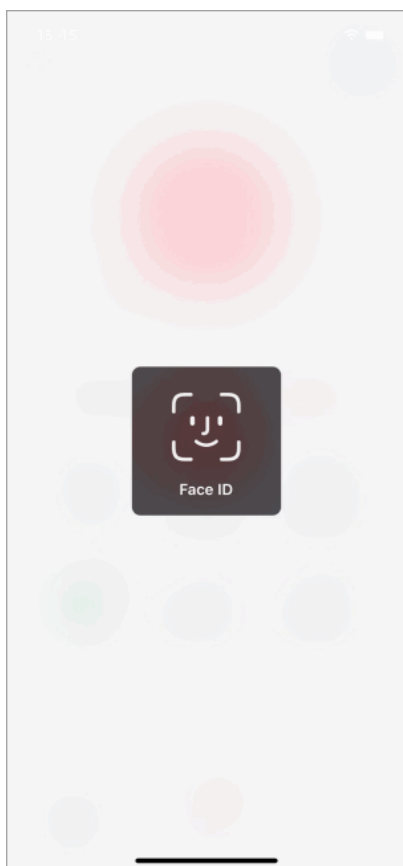


- Dark gray indicates the option is available for your device
- Light gray indicates the option is not available for your device
- Hit 'OK' after making your selection
- Confirm the passcode type accordingly to open the main Vault interface

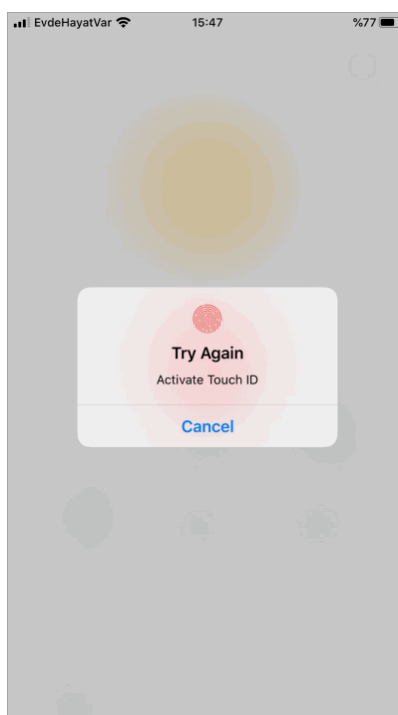


- You have to provide your chosen authentication method each time you open the vault:

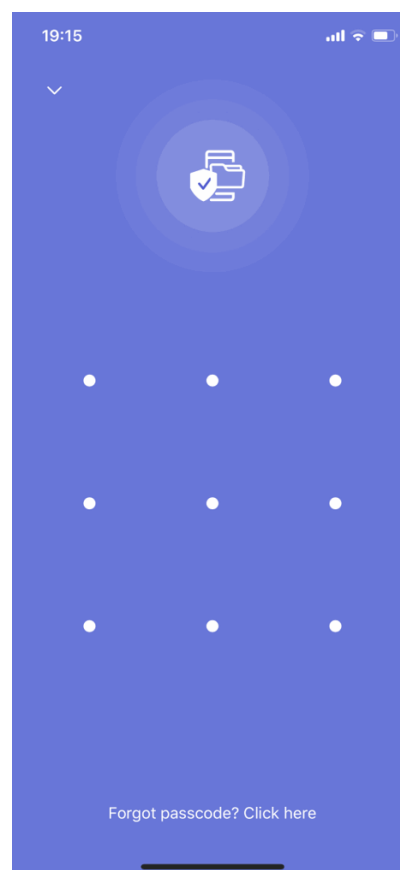

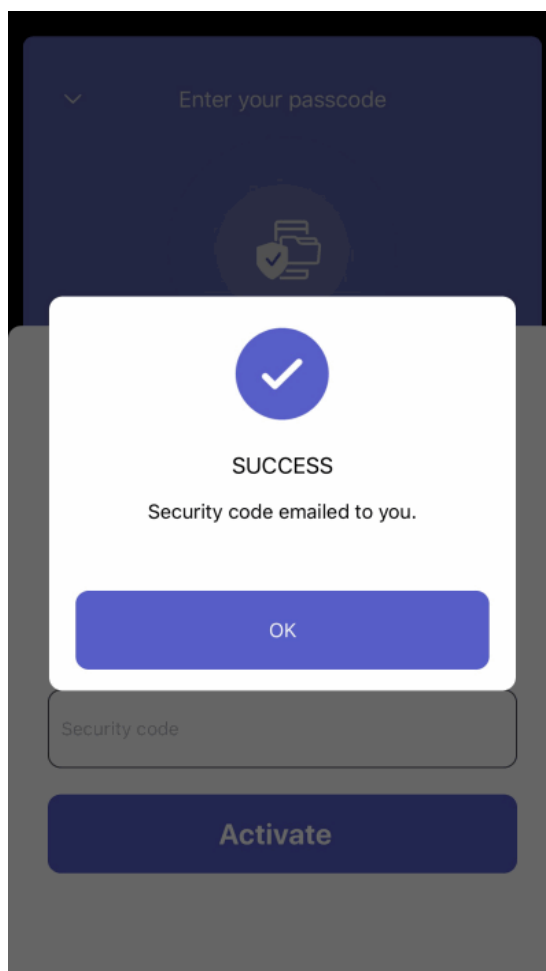

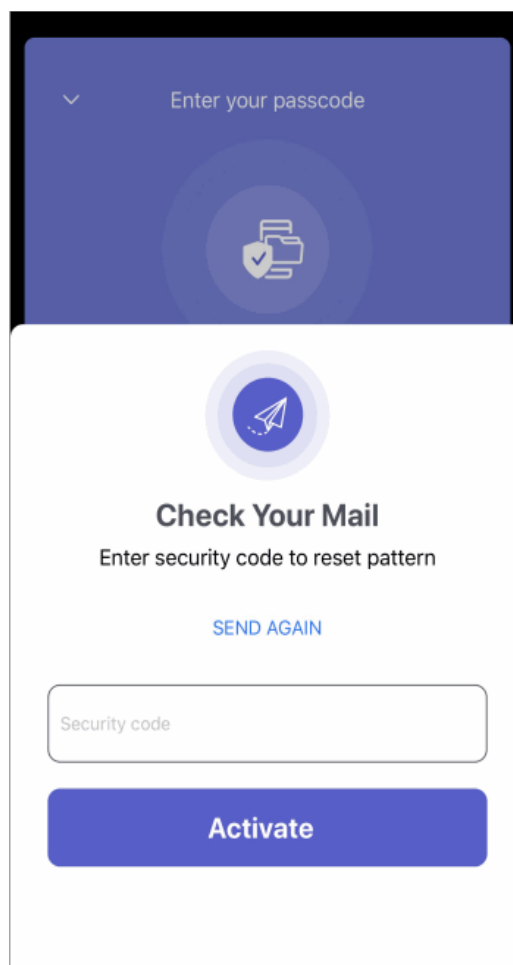

- Tap 'Forgot passcode?' if you can't remember your security pattern:



- Hit 'OK'
- A password reset code is sent to your registered email account
- Enter the code in the field, hit 'OK'



- Tap 'Activate'

You can reset the security pattern as explained above.

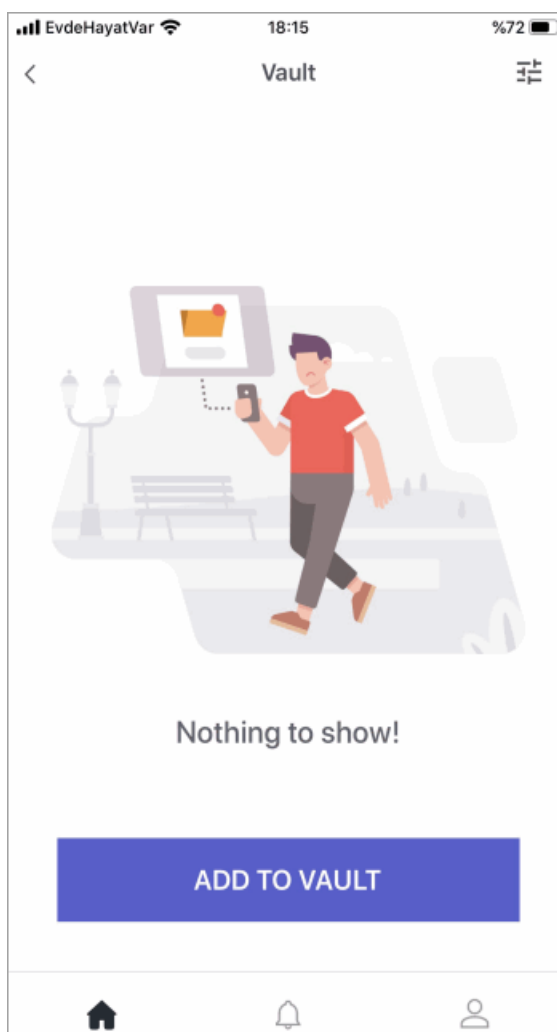

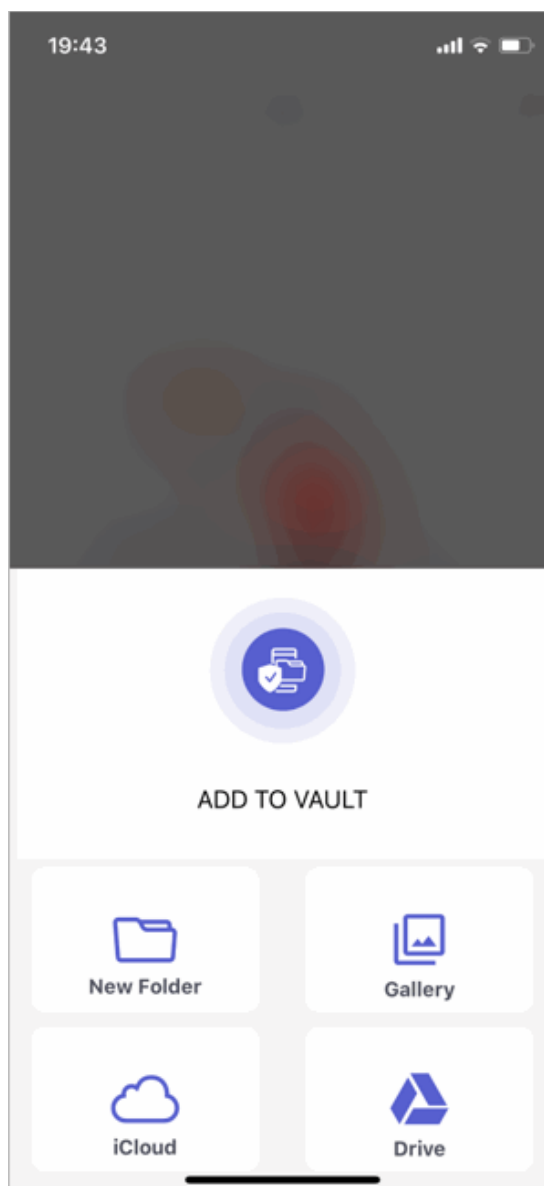
Create a folder

- Open Comodo Mobile Security
- Login to your account

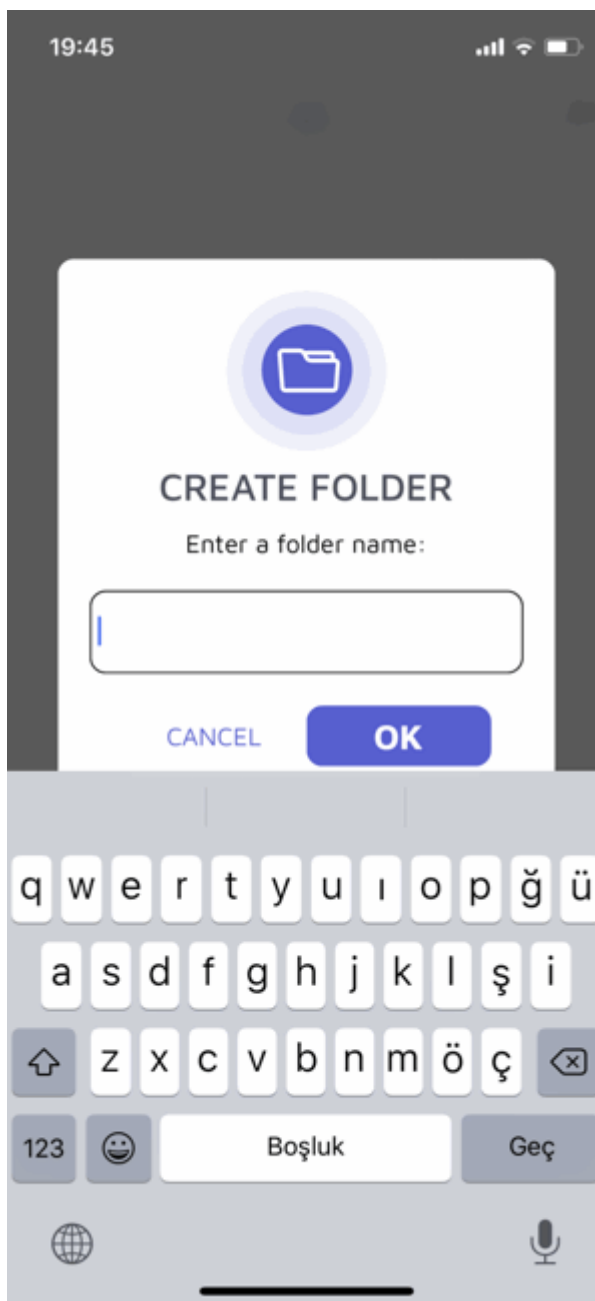
- Tap 'Vault' on CMS home screen
- Authenticate using face id, fingerprint or security pattern



- Touch the 'Add to Vault' button



- Touch 'New Folder'



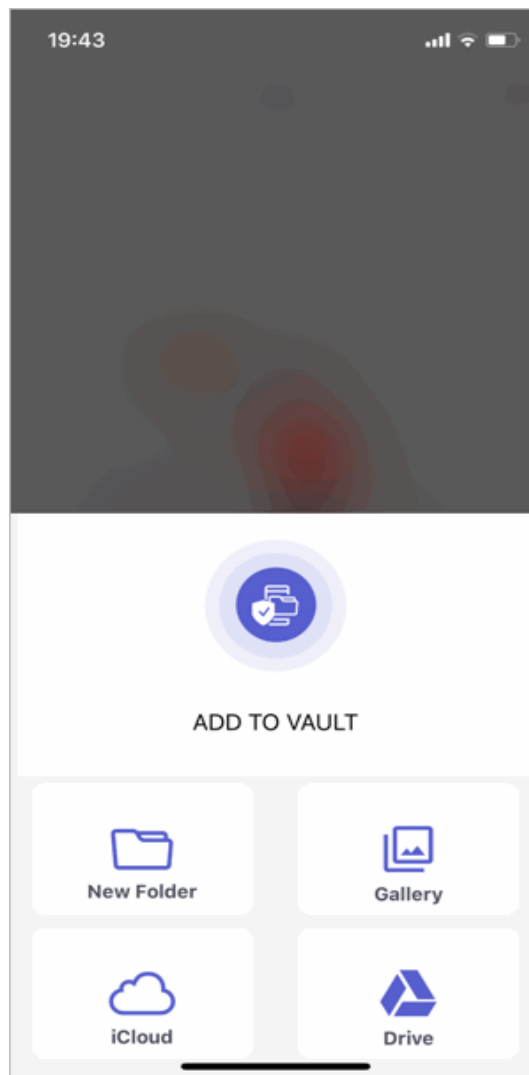
- Enter a name and hit 'OK' to create a new folder
- To create a sub folder, tap the parent folder and follow the same procedure explained above



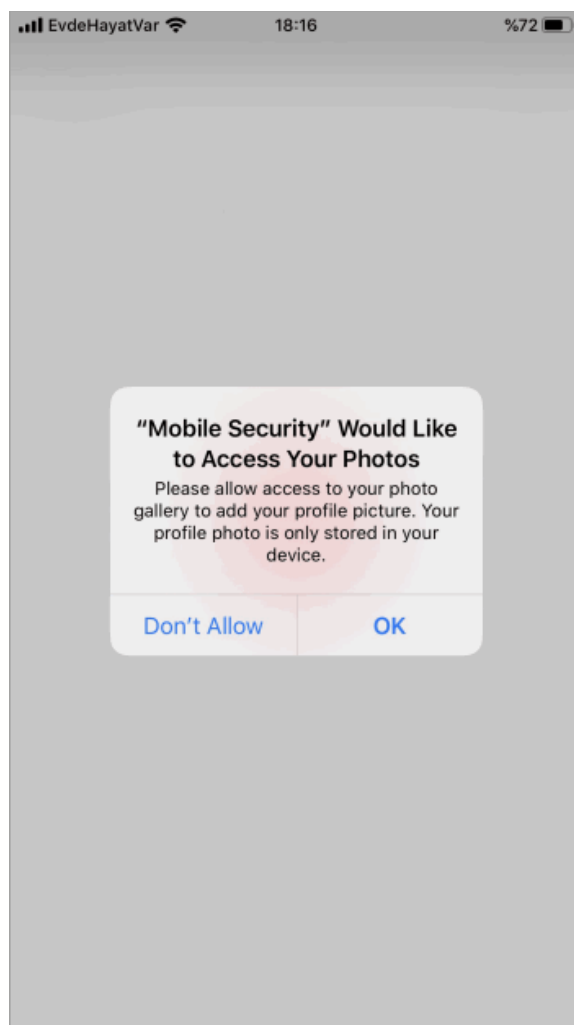
- Follow the same procedure to create more sub-folders
- Tap the arrow at bottom-left to navigate to parent folder

Add items from the gallery

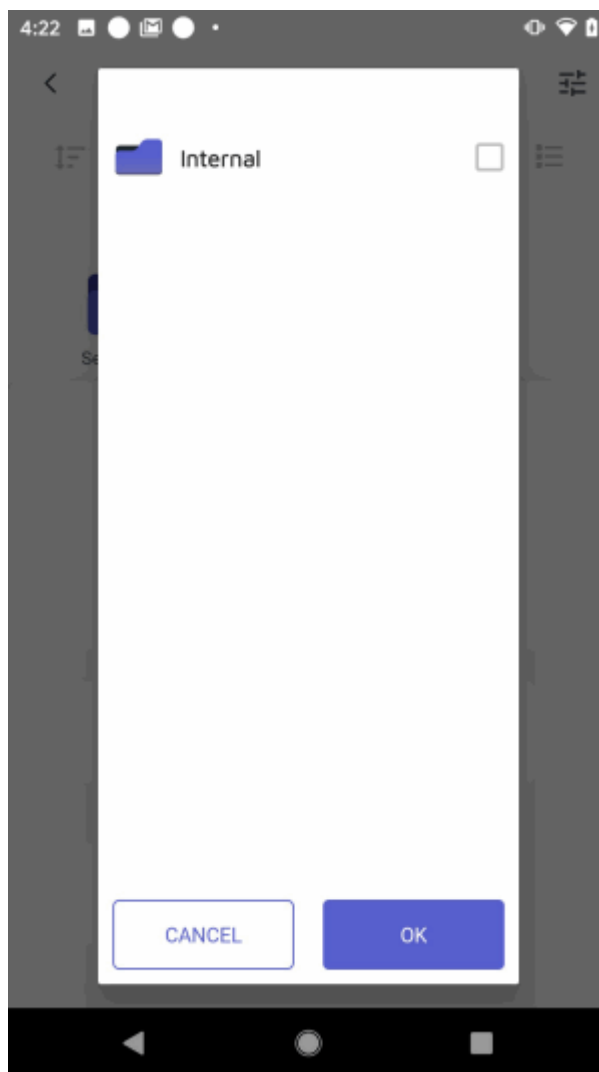
- Open Comodo Mobile Security
- Login to your account
- Tap 'Vault' on CMS home screen
- Authenticate using face id, fingerprint or security pattern
- (optional) Tap the folder / sub folder that you want to add the items to
- Touch the '+' button




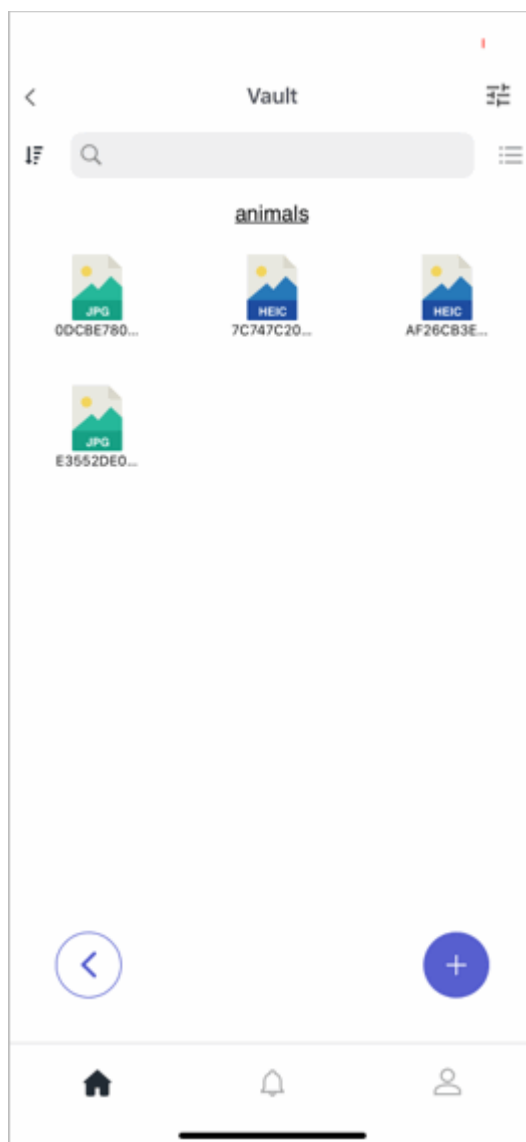
- Tap 'Gallery'
- Allow 'Comodo Mobile Security Antivirus' to access items on your device:



- To add the folder(s) select the check box(es) and hit 'OK'

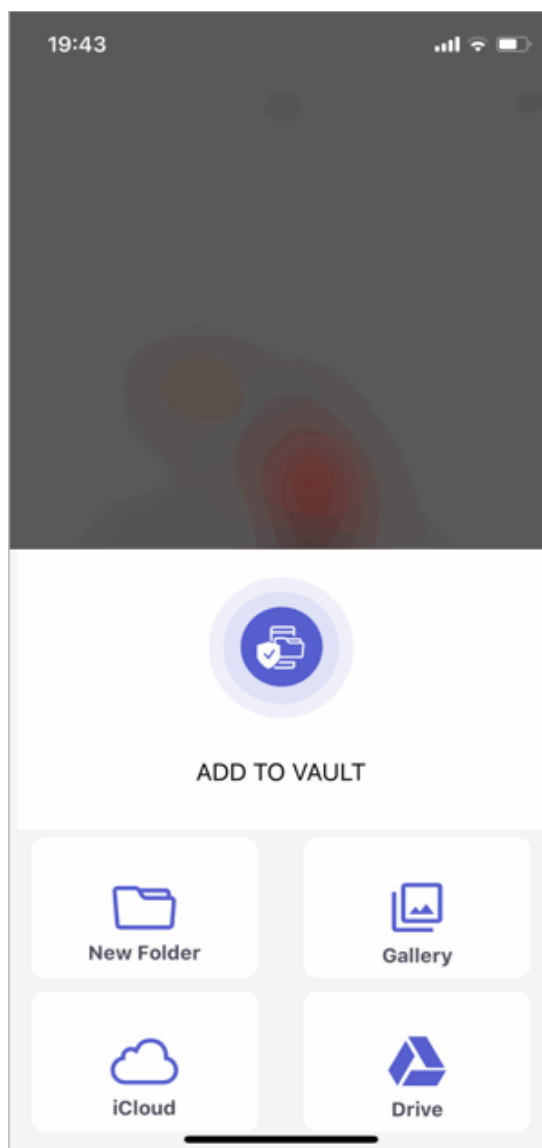


- To select individual items inside a folder, touch the folder and navigate to the item, select it and hit 'OK'
- Navigate to different folders / items by using the back button on your device, or hit the folder icon with ellipses  at the top
- The selected folder(s) / items are added to the vault:

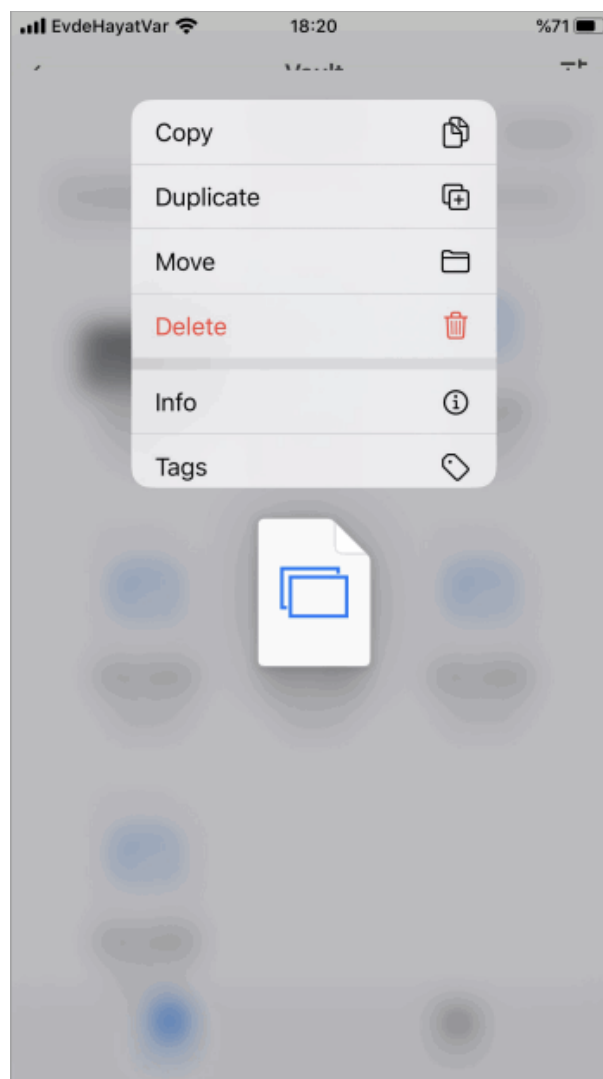
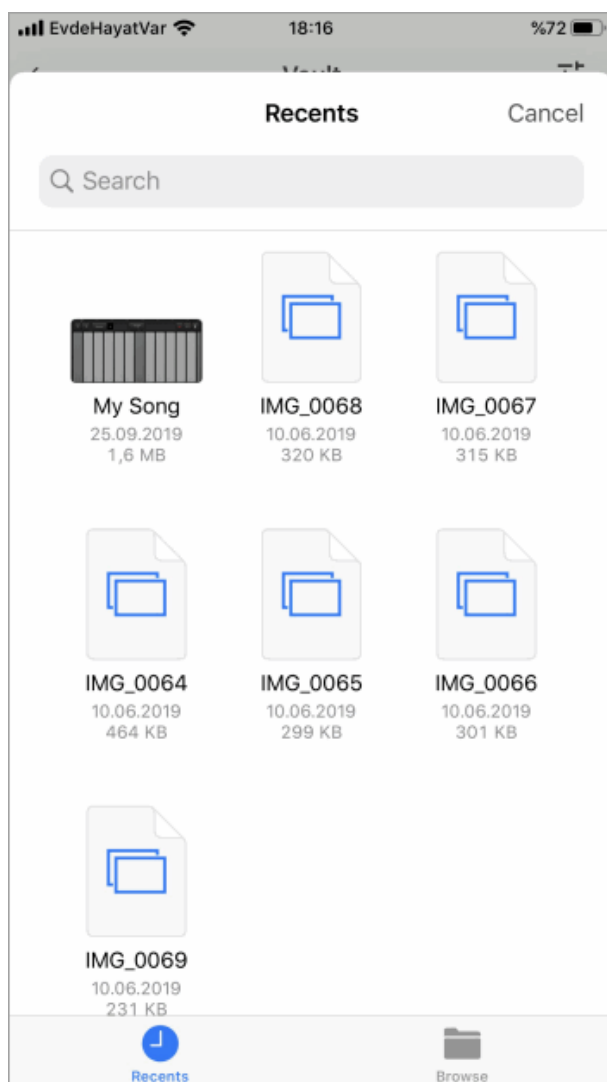


Add items from iCloud

- Open Comodo Mobile Security app
- Login to your account
- Tap 'Vault' on CMS home screen
- Authenticate using face id, fingerprint or security pattern
- Tap 'iCloud'



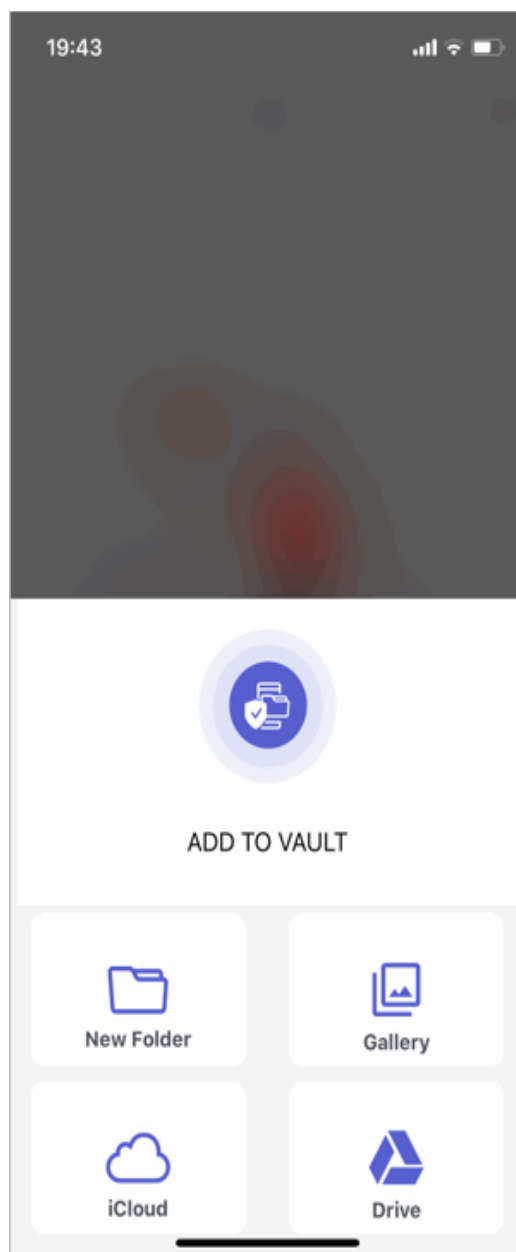
- Tap the item you want to manage



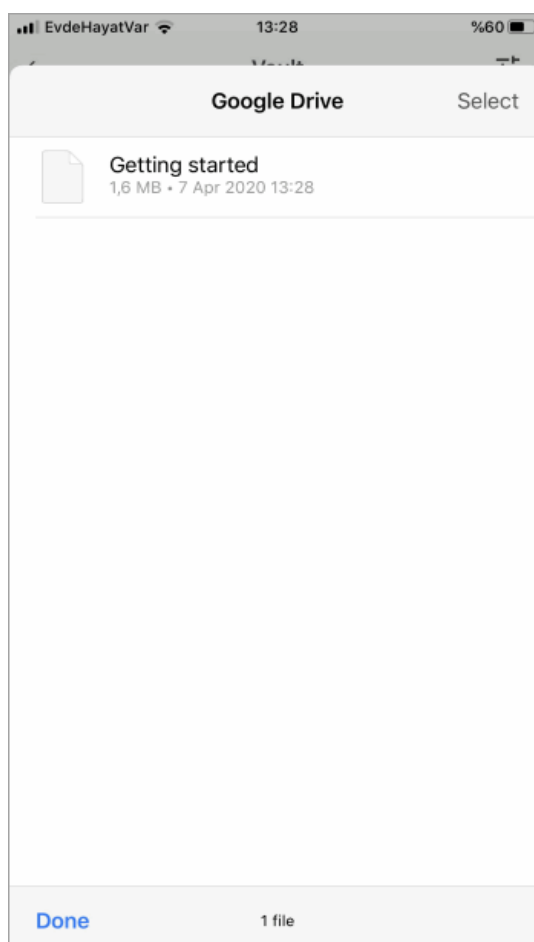
The available options are as follows: copy file, create a duplicate file, move the file to another location within Vault area, delete a file, view file's info and tag a file to favorite in the Vault area.

Add items from Google Drive

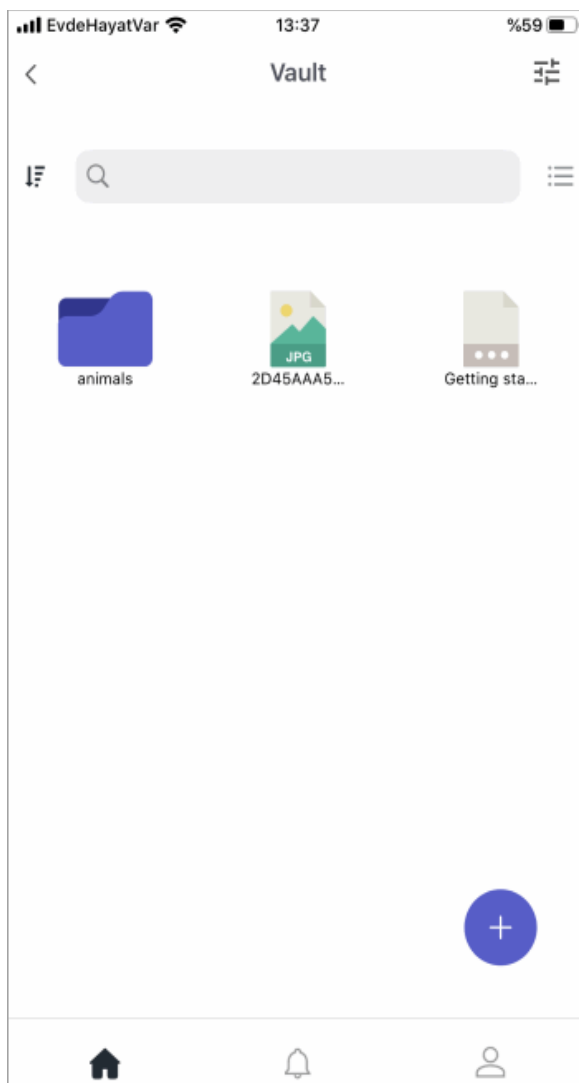
- Open Comodo Mobile Security app
- Login to your account
- Tap 'Vault' on CMS home screen
- Authenticate using face id, fingerprint or security pattern
- (optional) Tap the folder / sub folder that you want to add the items to
- Touch the '+' button



- Tap 'Drive'



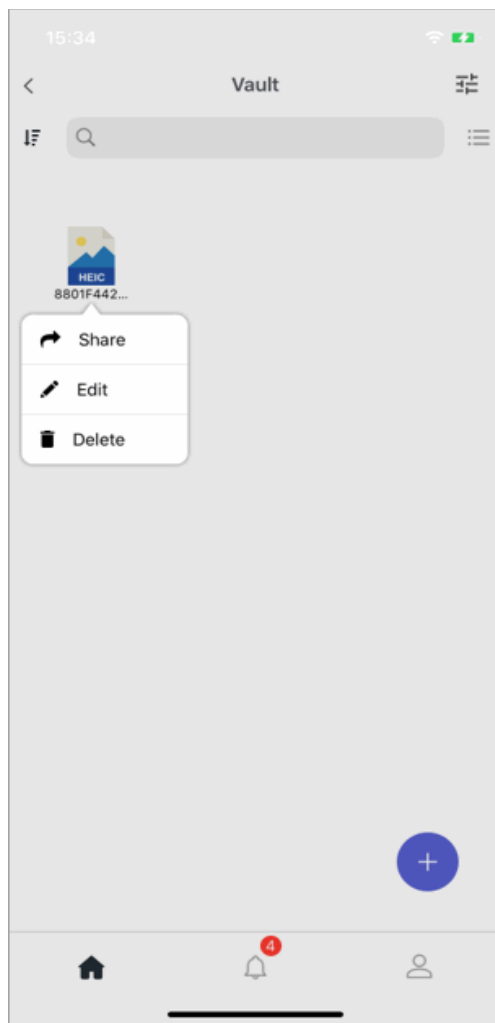
- Touch an item in the drive and tap 'Select'



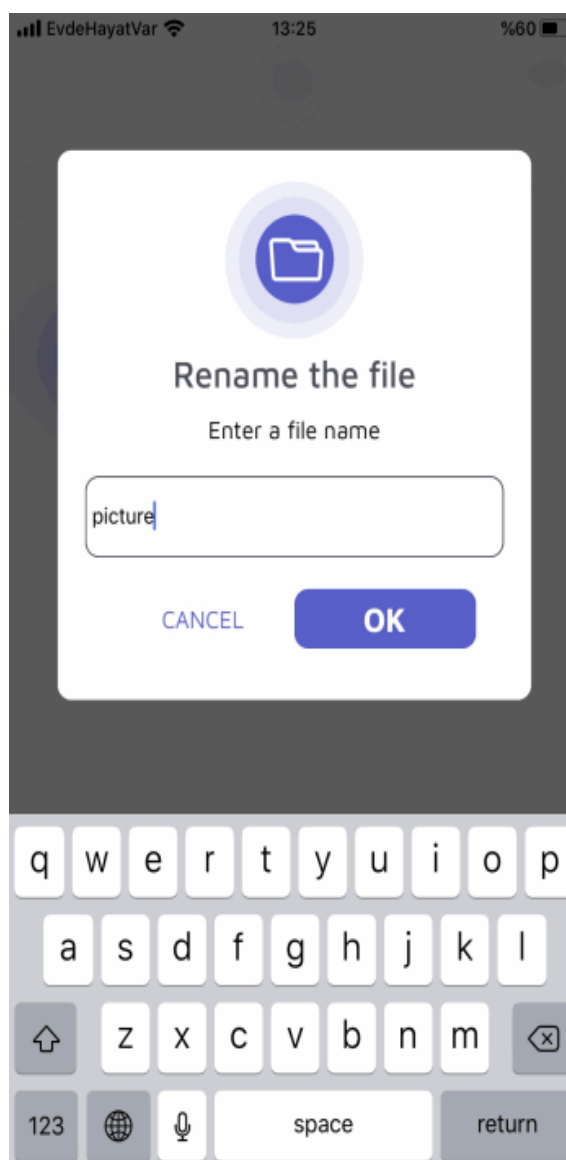
- Repeat the process to add more items from your drive to vault

Edit a file / folder name

- Open Comodo Mobile Security app
- Login to your account
- Tap 'Vault' on CMS home screen
- Authenticate using face id, fingerprint or security pattern
- Navigate to the file / folder and long press on it



- Tap 'Edit'



- Enter a new name and hit 'OK'.

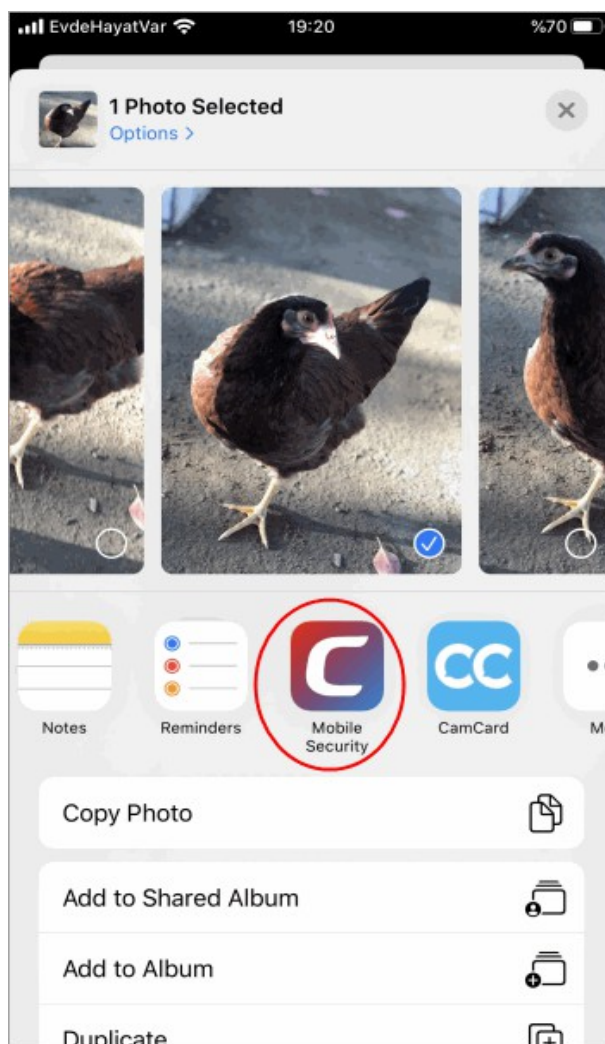
Delete a file / folder

- Open Comodo Mobile Security
- Login to your account
- Tap 'Vault' on CMS home screen
- Authenticate using face id, fingerprint or security pattern
- Navigate to the file / folder and long press on it
- Tap 'Delete' and hit 'Yes' in the confirmation dialog

Copy items to Vault

You can copy items from your phone to CMS vault.

- Select an item in your phone and choose option to send



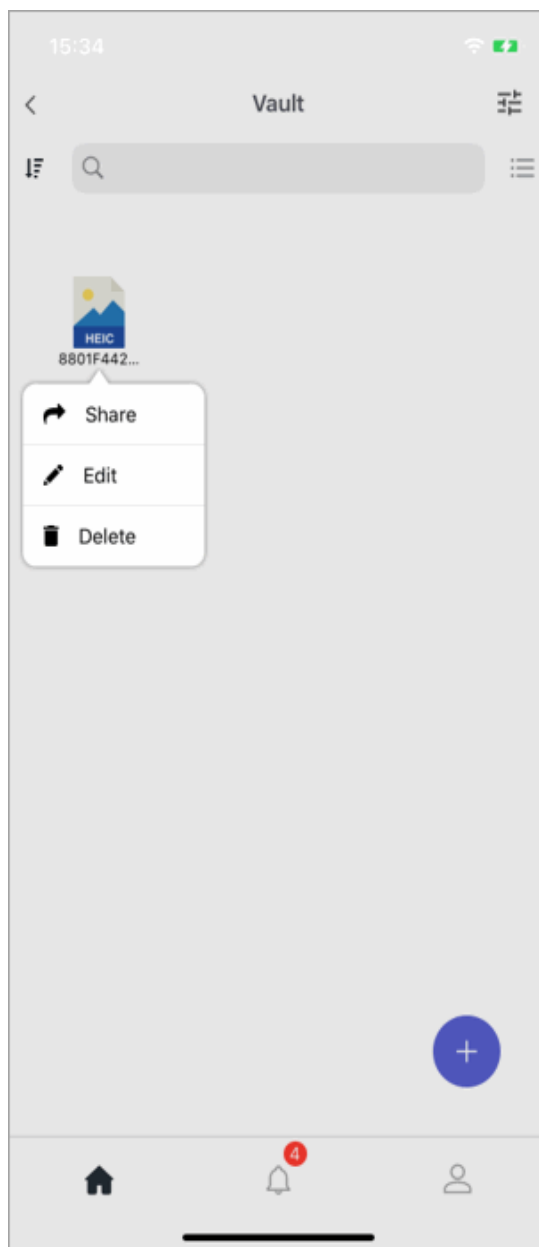
- Tap 'Comodo Mobile Security Antivirus'. Note - The screen may vary depending on iOS version, phone model and the selected option (share or send)
- Authenticate using face id, fingerprint or security pattern



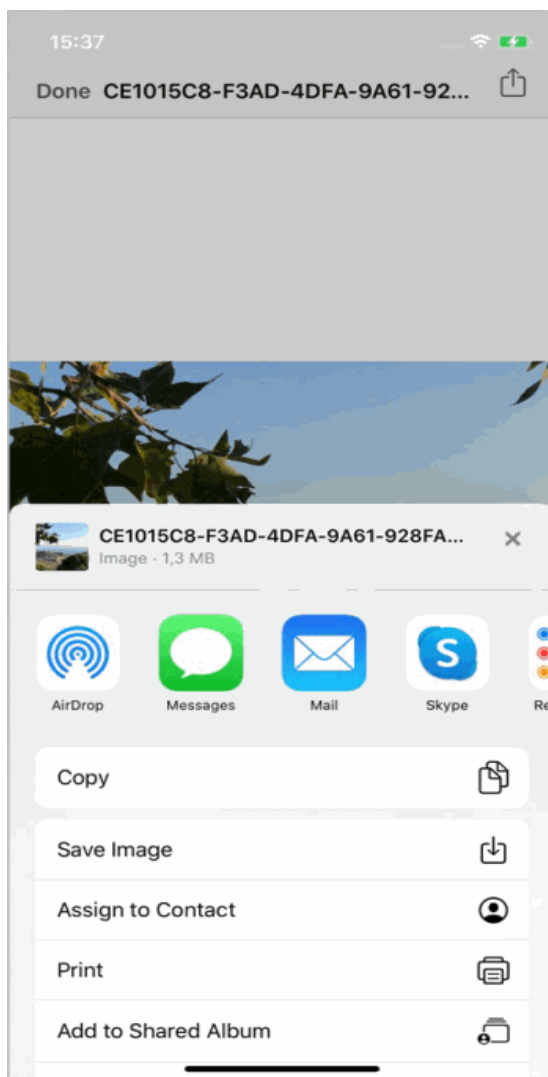
- Hit 'OK' to copy to main vault folder or tap a folder / sub folder and touch 'OK'

Share items from the Vault

- Open Comodo Mobile Security
- Login to your account
- Tap 'Vault' on CMS home screen
- Authenticate using face id, fingerprint or security pattern
- Navigate to the file / folder and long press on it
- Tap 'Share'



- Tap the app that you want to copy to



- Note - You can copy items from vault to available apps (with shareable properties) in your phone.

Sort, search and change file view

- Open Comodo Mobile Security
- Login to your account
- Tap 'Vault' on the CMS home screen
- Authenticate using face id, fingerprint or security pattern

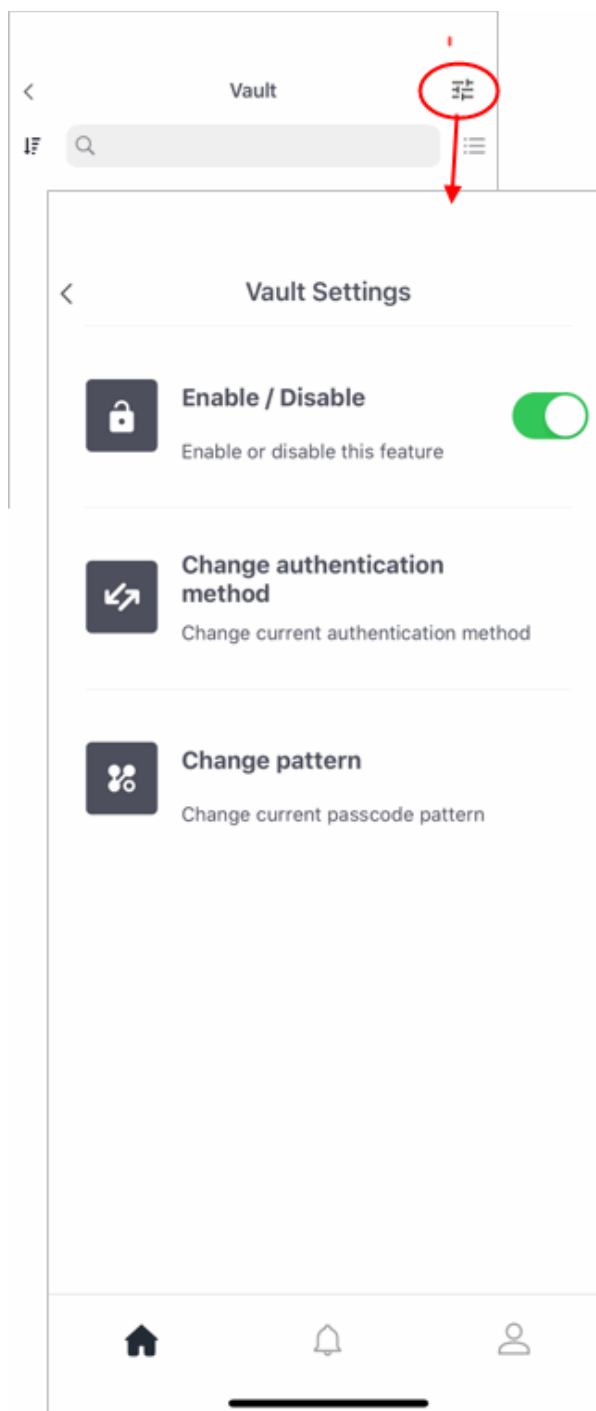


- **Search** - Enter the name of the item in the search field at the top. Matching results is shown as you start entering the name.
- **Sort** - Tap the sort button at top-left to sort items in ascending / descending order.
- **File View** - Tap the table / list view button at top-right to change the file view.

Change authentication method

You can change the vault authentication type any time you want.

- Open Comodo Mobile Security
- Login to your account
- Tap 'Vault' on the CMS home screen
- Authenticate using face id, fingerprint or security pattern
- Touch the vault settings button at top-right



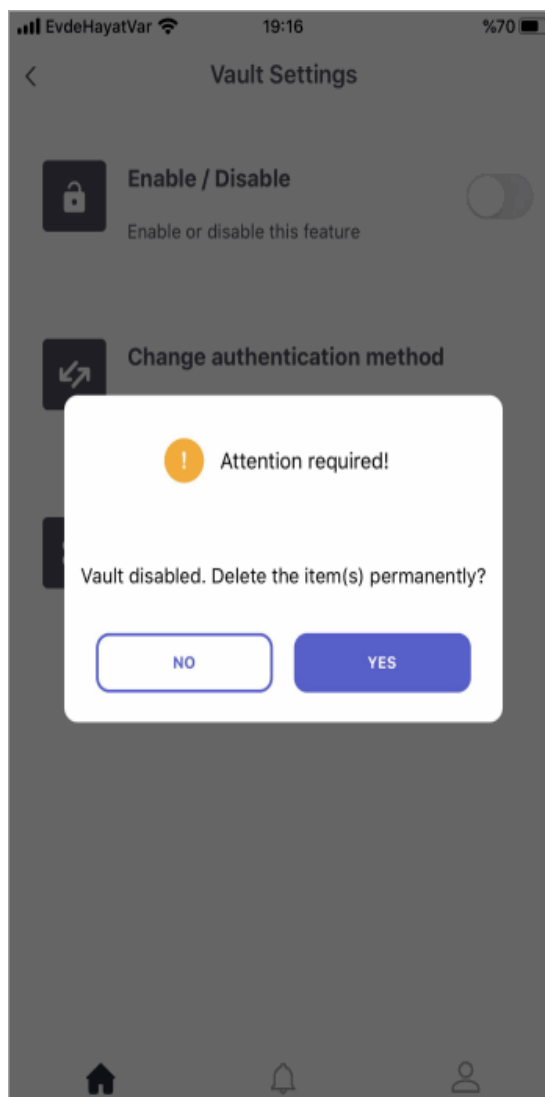
- **Enable / Disable** - Allows you to disable vault. See **next section** for more details.
- **Change authentication method** - Allows you to switch to Face ID, Touch ID or Passcode authentication methods. **Click here** to more details.
- **Change pattern** - Shows if you have chosen pattern security type. Tap anywhere on the row and provide a new pattern and confirm it.
- Next time authenticate to vault with the new method.

Disable the Vault feature

You can enable / disable the vault feature as follows:

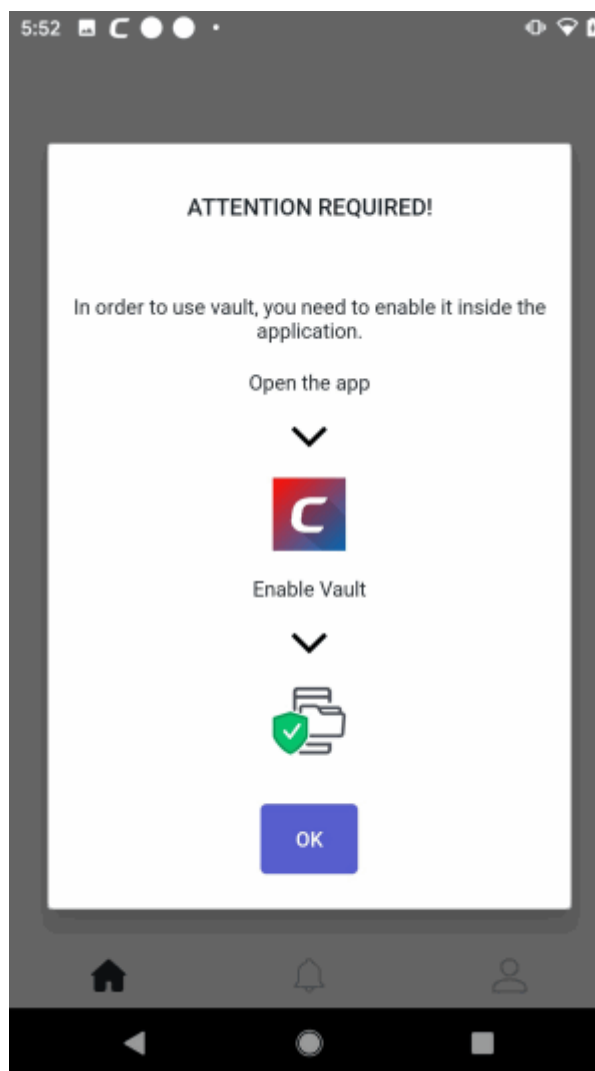
- Open Comodo Mobile Security

- Login to your account
- Tap 'Vault' on the CMS home screen
- Authenticate using face id, fingerprint or security pattern
- Touch the vault settings button at top-right
- Touch anywhere on the 'Enable / Disable' row



- **No** - All items in the vault are retained. You have to enable again by providing a new authentication method.
- **Yes** - All items in the vault are deleted.

Copying an item to vault when it is disabled will show an alert:

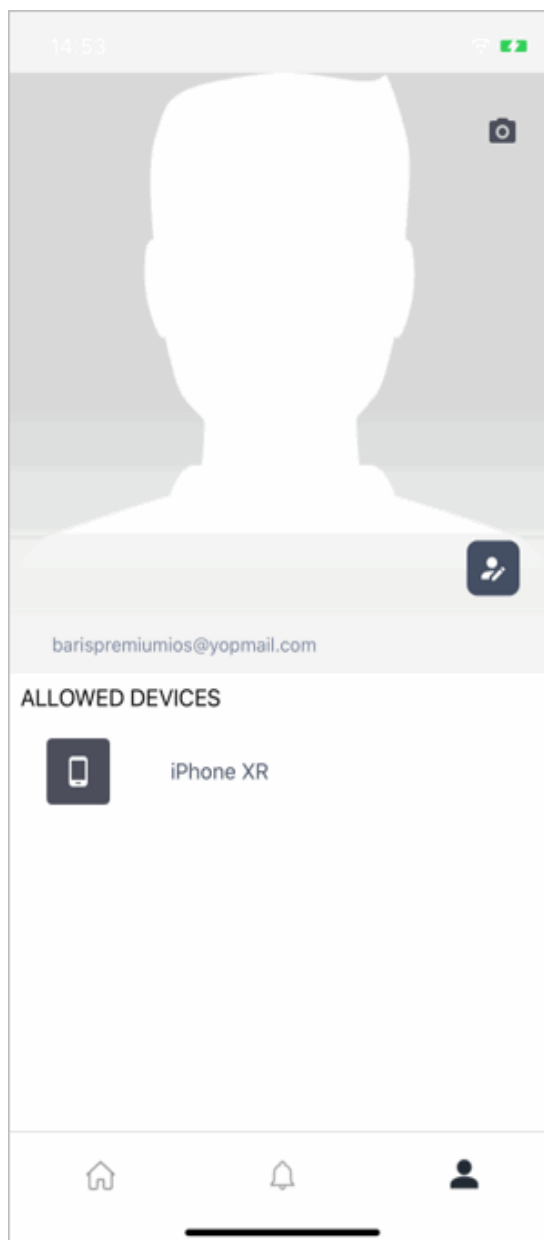


Touch 'OK' and complete the authentication setup method as explained **above**.


11. Manage User Profile

Tap the user icon at the bottom-right of the home screen

- The profile screen lets you manage your display name, profile picture, account password, and more.
- Note - you cannot change the email address associated with your account.




Change your display name

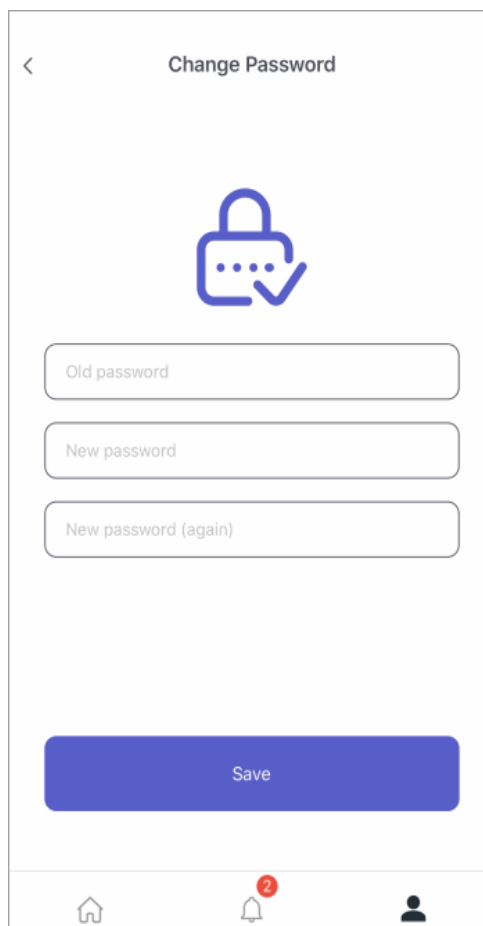
- Tap the user icon at the bottom-right of the home screen
- Touch the pencil icon  beside your user name
- Edit your first and last name as required:

- Tap 'Save'.
- Your password will be updated. You should use your new password the next time you login to CMS.

Change your profile picture

- Tap the user icon at the bottom-right of the home screen.
- Touch the camera in the profile picture area.
- Browse to the picture you want to use.
- Position and re-size the grid until the part of picture you want to use is inside the edges
- Touch 'Crop' at top-right to apply your selection and set it as your profile picture

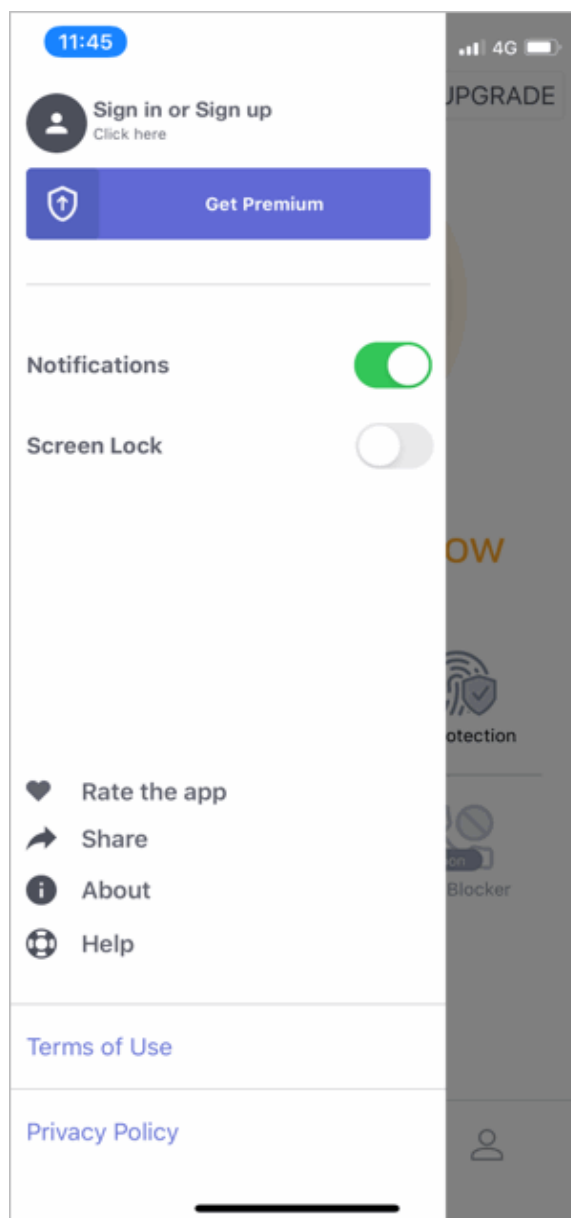
Manage enrolled devices

- The devices enrolled to your account are shown below your profile picture.

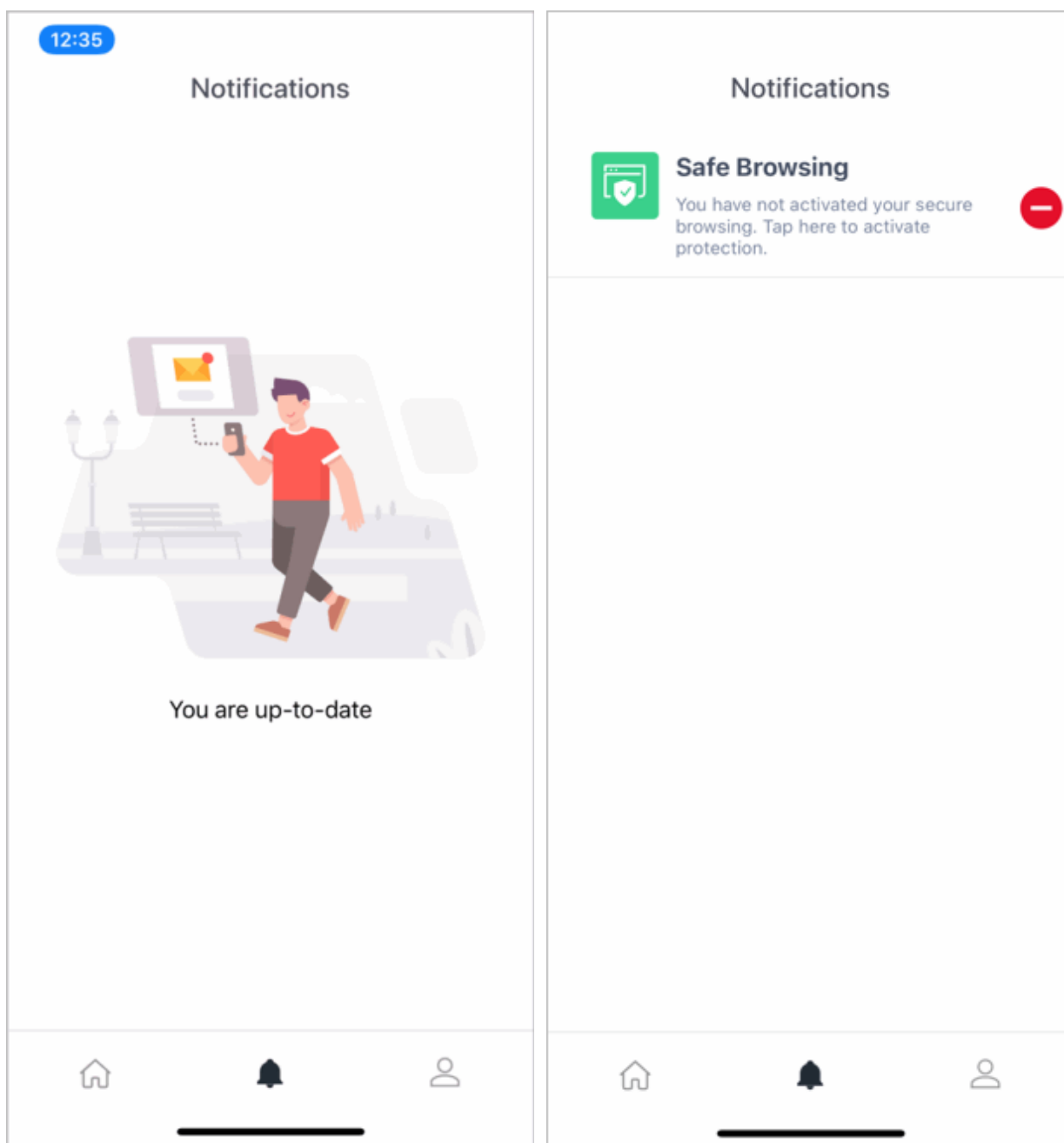
12. View Notifications

The notifications area lets you configure which items you would like CMS to alert you about.

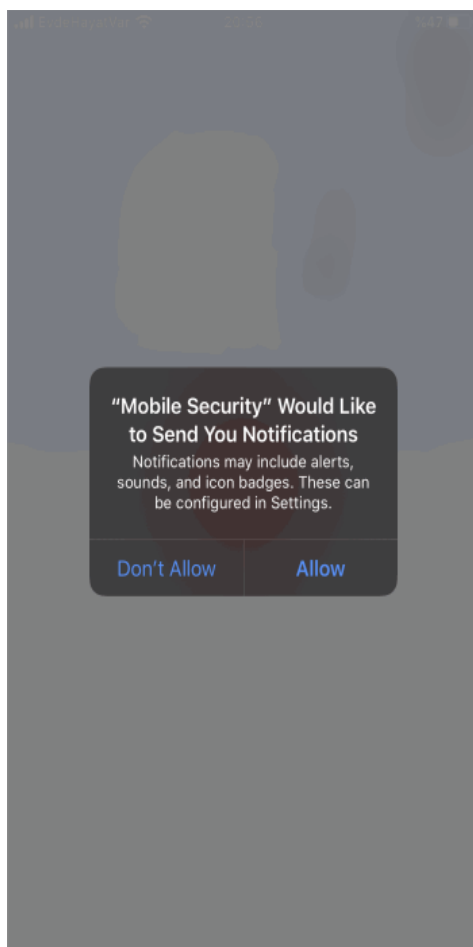
- Open Comodo Mobile Security

- Move the notifications slider to the right



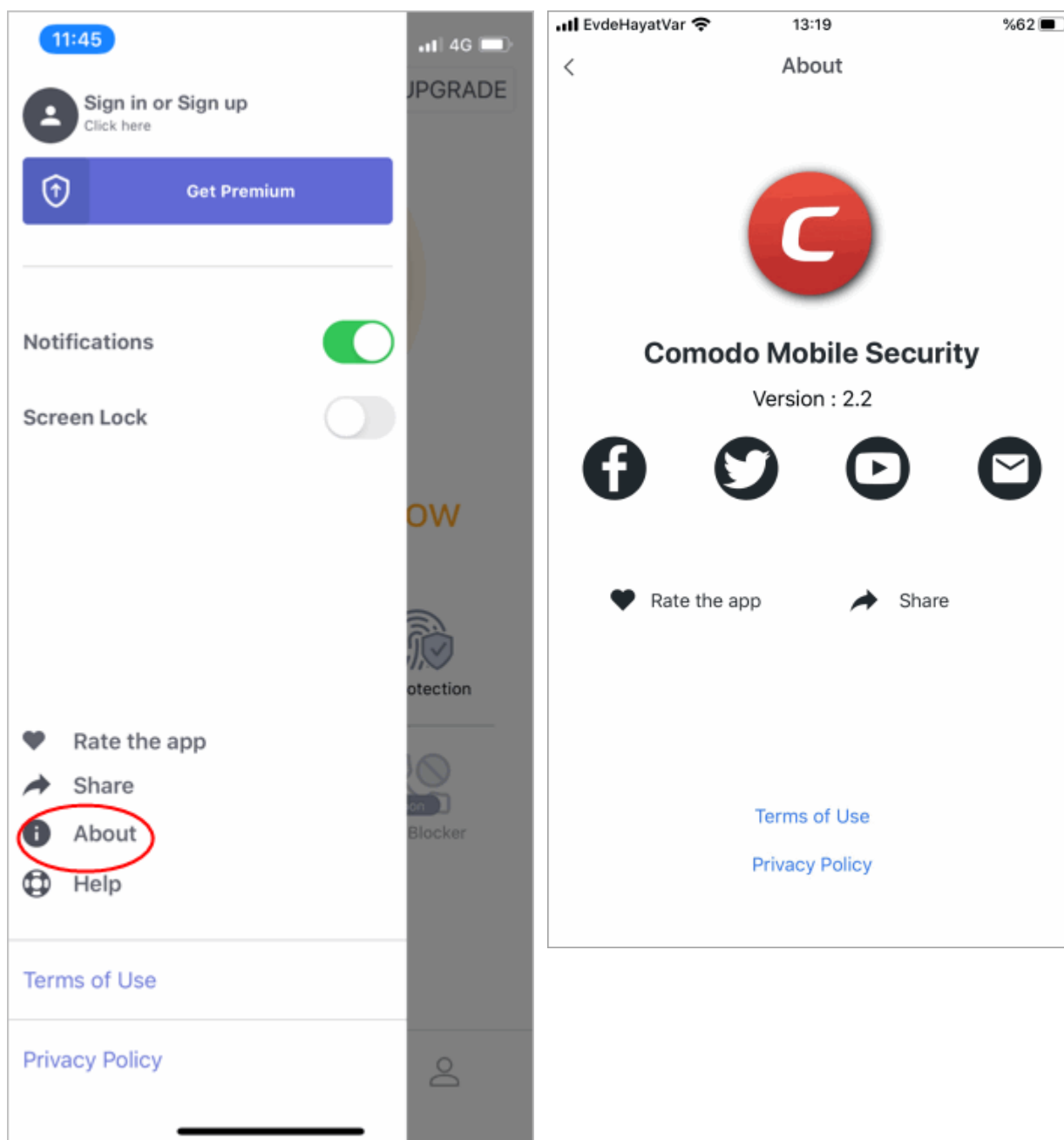
- Allow notifications for Comodo Mobile Security in 'Settings' > 'Mobile Security' > 'Notifications'
- The status will turn to active
- Tap 'Allow' to let Comodo Mobile Security send you alerts:

- Tap 'About'

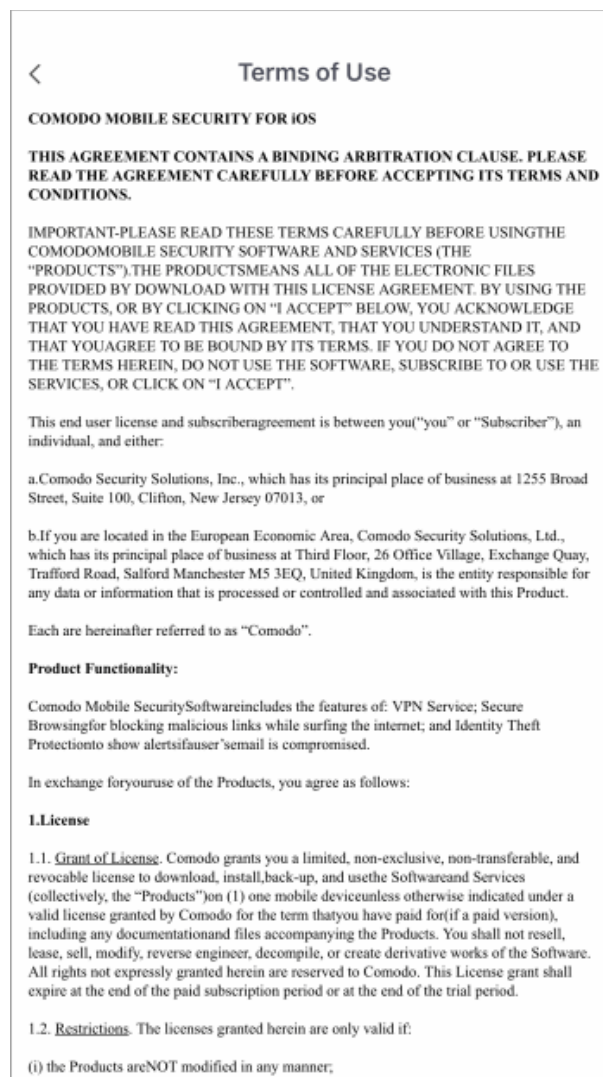
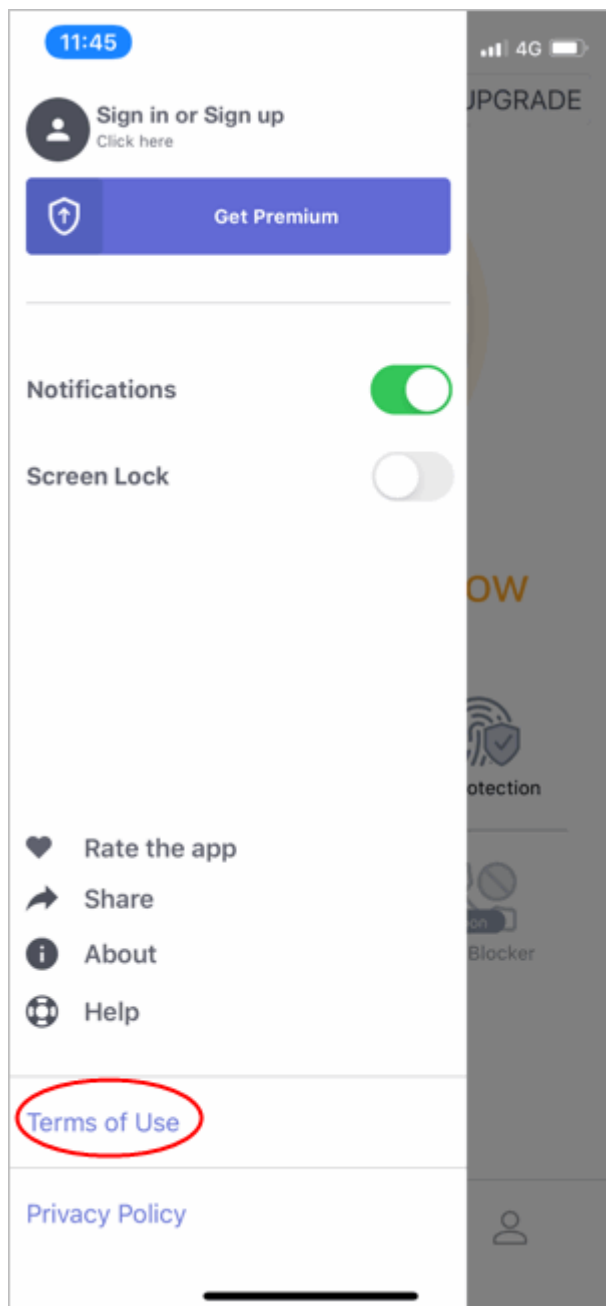
